That By-Law No. 52, being a by-law for the purpose of furnishing indigent relief to persons who are in need and not eligible to receive social allowance, having been read a first time, be now read a second and third time and passed.

That By-Law No. 53 being a by-law for the purpose of creating a Reserve Fund for Replacement of Machinery and Equipment, having been read a first time, be now read a second and third time and passed.

G. Goossen-H.Earl:

That we contract with Hans, Peter, Langes, Winnipeg, as architect re the construction of a new office building, as set out in the "Client and Architects" agreement.

G.Goossen-W.Recksiedler:

That we call for tenders to demolish the Court House Building and remove all debris by May 31st. Tenders to be in hands of the Secretary-Treasurer by April 13th.

B. Klassen-W.F.Recksiedler:


That we appoint the following members to a committee re the new office building:
