The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The minutes of March 10th regular meeting and of March 28th Special meeting were adopted as read by motion of B.Klassen & M.Ribordy.

G. Goossen-H.Earl: That we request the Manitoba Hydro to remove the following pole lines:

1. along the Brandt Road in Section 7-6-1 EPM; and
2. along road allowance in the Village of Rosenort as far as "Kroeker" Street in Section 8-6-1 EPM; and
3. North of North East quarter of Sec. 14-5-1 WPM.

E. Saurette-M.Ribordy: That we request the Highways Department to install the following culverts at the locations shown, to alleviate drainage problems:-

Prov. Road 205 - 1 mile East of the Village of McTavish
larger culvert.

Prov. Road 246 - River Lot 512 - another 30" culvert.

Prov. Road 336 - Larger culverts on approaches in Sec's 6-6-2W
and Sec's 19 and 31 in Twp. 5, Rge 2 WPM
" " 336 A larger culvert 1 mile North of PTH #23.

Prov. Road 523 - another 36" culvert North of Sec. 17-4-1E.

P.T.H. #23 - thru crossing in North Road ditch $\frac{3}{4}$ mile
West of Lowe Farm.

W.F.Recksiedler-H.Earl: Due to amendments to the Wage Act regarding Heavy Construction, be it resolved that the following rates of pay be set for our employees, effective May 1st, 1967:

All Caterpillar tractor and Road Patrol operators @ \$1.90 an hour
and Dragline operator @ \$2.20 an hour;
and furthermore that the time allowed for maintenance of equipment be reduced to one hour a day.

Ben Klassen-Ed. Saurette: That we accept the tender of "Reimer Bros" of Homewood offering to demolish the Court House Building for \$2,200. plus salvage and have the necessary agreement completed calling for the completion of demolition by May 31st, 1967.

W.F.Recksiedler-G.Goossen: That By-Law No. 954 being a by-law for the purpose of entering into an agreement with "Reimer Bros" of Homewood to demolish the Court House Building in Morris and remove the debris, be read a first time, read a second and third time and passed.

M.Ribordy-Ed.Saurette: That the Office be closed on April 27th and 28th to permit the moving of office equipment and supplies to our temporary office in the Old Post Office Building in Morris. Regular office hours to continue on Monday, May 1st.

Ben Klassen-M.Ribordy: That By-Law No. 955 being a by-law for the purpose of amending Section 1 of By-Law No. 947 to read:

"That the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris shall hold its regular monthly meetings in the Old Post Office Building in the Town of Morris on the second Friday of each month, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, during the year 1967", be read a first time, read a second and third time and passed.

G. Goossen-H.Earl: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$63,244.96 be passed for payment.

Representatives of the Rosenort Park & Rink committee solicited support for the building of a closed skating rink, It was suggested to form a local improvement district for the area benefiting through this project. Further study to be made.

The meeting adjourned.
