The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members, excepting M. Ribordy, present. It was moved by W.Recksiedler, seconded by E. Saurette that the minutes of July 14th regular meeting and of July 28th Special Meeting be adopted as read.

B.Klassen-H.Earl: That we approve of the purchase of the following bridge material from Billinkoffs:

150	lengths of 2 x 4 - 24' (treated)	
100	" 3 x 12- 20' fir	
200	" 3 x 12- 22' fir	Carried

W.Recksiedler-B.Klassen: That we pay Paul Comeault of St. Jean \$68.72 being damages incurred to his tractor when it broke through a culvert on a municipal road. Carried

G. Goossen-H.Earl: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$22,877.41 be passed for payment. Carried


Application for Prairie Assistance will be made at the next meeting when crop yields can be assessed more fully.

A general discussion took place regarding Waste Disposal Fields in the municipality. It was suggested to start the "Pit" system as well as centralizing these fields in about 3 areas in the municipality. Further consideration will be given this matter with a view to implementing same in 1968.

Ward appropriations and those of the Bridge and Local Drainage accounts came under review.
