The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date, with councillors Ribordy, Saurette and Earl absent, due to illness and holidays.

Ben Klassen-G.oossen: That the minutes of Sept. 8th regular meeting and those of the Special Meetings of Sept. 12th and October 4th be adopted as read. Carried

W.Recksiedler-G.Goossen: That we request the Water Control and Conservation Branch to express an opinion regarding the necessity of installing a trap on the culvert at the SE corner of 24-4-1WPM as requested by Sam Hoffman of Morris. Carried

W.Recksiedler-B.Klassen: That we accept the tender of J.R.Friesen and Son Ltd., Morris for our Anti-Freeze requirements at \$2.39 a gal. Carried

B.Klassen-W.Recksiedler: That the Highways Dept. be requested to inspect the drainage problem along the East side of Main Street in Sperling, between Robert St. and Waddell St. and install a culvert at the junction of Robert St. and Main St., if this appears to be the solution. Carried

B. Klassen-G.Goossen: That we request permission from the C.N.R. to install an 18" culvert through its roadbed at the North East corner of Sec. 36-4-2W and also at the North East corner of ~~36~~<sup>36</sup>-4-2W. Carried


W.Recksiedler-B.Klassen: That we request the Highways Department permission to dyke the "Moyer Drain" North of NE 7-4-1EPM up to Provincial Road No. 523 and move approach close to the drain. Carried


G.Goossen-W.Recksiedler: That the appeals of the Assessor, as set out in "Exhibit B-1" covering changes of ownership, assessment values, etc. be approved. Carried

Councillors Recksiedler, Saurette, Klassen and Goossen, as well as the secretary, were delegated to view office furniture for the new building and authorized to purchase same if found suitable.

G. Goossen-W.Recksiedler: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$101,265.80 be passed for payment. Carried

The meeting adjourned. The next regular meeting will be held on Friday, November 10th, 1967 with W.F.Recksiedler, deputy reeve in the chair, due to Reeve Anderson being away on holidays to Scotland at that time.
