

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. It was moved by Ben Klassen & seconded by G. Cretton that the minutes of January 12th regular meeting and those of January 22nd Special meeting be adopted as read.

H. Earl-E.Saurette: That we authorize all members of Council to attend the "Municipal Officials Course" to be held in Brandon on March 4, 5 & 6th and that the municipality pay expenses incurred therewith. Carried

G.P.Goossen-W.F.Recksiedler: That the Electors' Roll of 1967 be adopted as the Electors Roll for 1968 and the Clerk be authorized to amend said list by adding thereto or deleting therefrom names omitted or persons not entitled to vote; and correcting any other errors in the list. (Municipal Act, Sec 50(4) and 52(3). Carried

Ben Klassen-W.F.Recksiedler: That we purchase 10 stacking chairs for the Council Chambers at \$19.50 each and 10 ash trays for same @ \$6.00 each. Carried.

E. Saurette-W.F.Recksiedler: That we request the Highways Department to give serious consideration of Black-Topping Provincial Road #205 from P.T.H. #75 to the Village of Aubigny. Carried

H.D.Earl-E.Saurette: That the 40 surplus folding chairs of the municipality be offered to the Morris Branch of the Royal Canadian Legion at the price of \$1.00 each. Carried

G.P.Goossen: That we request the Water Control Branch to install a trap on the culvert South side of the "Blackhurst Drain" in the NW 26-6-1WPM to prevent back-up into the field. Carried

H.D.Earl-G.P.Goossen: That we request the Water Control and Conservation Branch to advise the proper size of culverts to replace bridges at the following locations:

Brown Drain Parallel at SW 9-6-1W.
Russell Drain at NE 22-5-1W
Tobacco Creek Extension- SW 22-5-1W.

G. Cretton-G.Goossen: That we adopt the proposed agreement respecting the proportionment of local drainage costs between the Rural Municipalities of Dufferin, Roland and Morris and forward copies of said agreement for acceptance to these municipalities. Carried

W.F.Recksiedler-G. Cretton: That the tender of Jacob H. Klassen of Lowe Farm, Man. for \$8,226.00 for our D6 Caterpillar Tractor, dozer and scraper, be accepted. Carried


Harold Earl-Ben Klassen: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$17,291.57 be ~~adopted~~ passed for payment. Carried


A Special Meeting of Council will be held on WEDNESDAY, Feb. 21/68 to meet with the Architect, Peter Langes, to Finalize plans for the completion of the downstairs offices in the Municipal Building. Time of meeting: 2 p.m.
