The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. It was moved by Ben Klassen and seconded by G.P.Goossen that the minutes of March 8th Special meeting and of March ~~10th~~ 8th regular meeting be adopted as read.

H.D.Earl-Gib. Cretton: That the Record of Estimates for 1968 covering expenditures and revenues pertaining to the Controllable portion of the Budget be approved as set out in "Schedule A". Carried

E. Saurette-G. Cretton: That we request the Water Control & Conservation Branch to check the status as to third order drains, the "Roberts" & "Hokenson" drains from the intersection of the "Union Point" and "Jenkins" drains to the "Taylor" drain. Carried

G. Goossen-E.Saurette: That we request the Water Control & Conservation Branch to check the status as to third order drain of the "McTavish" drain from the intersection of the Barringer & Slater drains to the outlet. Carried

Ben Klassen-W.Recksiedler: That By-Law No. 969 being a by-law for the purpose of transferring all the lands of the "Steinfeld" S.D. #1128 to the "Lowe Farm" Consolidated S.D. #2377, having been read a first time, be now read a second time and submitted to the Minister for approval. Carried

G. Cretton-E.Saurette: That By-Law No. 972 being a by-law for the purpose of updating the Civil Defence By-Laws and agreements for the Emergency Measures Area of Morris of which our corporation is a part, be now read a first time, read a second time and submitted to the Municipal Affairs Dept. for approval. Carried

G.P.Goossen-H.D.Earl: That By-Law No. 973, being a by-law of The Rural Municipality of Morris to adopt The Morris Planning Scheme 1968, be now given first reading. Carried

G.P.Goossen-H.D.Earl: That we request the Highways Branch to extend and raise the bridge in the Village of Rosenort on Provincial Road #205. Carried

W. Recksiedler-H.D.Earl: That we appoint Dick B. Eidse of RRL, Morris, Man. as arbitrator re the petition of Jack Loepp and others requesting the transfer of certain lands from the Silver Plains S.D. #123 to the Morris Consolidated School District #2421. Carried

Ben Klassen-G. Cretton: That we proceed with the surveying of proposed 6th street in the Village of Lowe Farm, providing purchase agreement of property for this purpose can be finalized. Carried

Ed. Saurette-G.P.Goossen: That we subscribe to an advertisement in the Cook Book sponsored by the Aubigny Ladies Catholic League to the value of \$25.00 Carried


G.P.Goossen-E.Saurette: That we request the Manitoba Hydro to install:
One 175 mercury vapor light on "Loewen Ave" in the Village of Rosenort;
and
One 185 watt mercury vapor light on NE 20-5-1 EPM;
and
Exchange the existing lights on the Ferry Road in the Village of Aubigny to 175 watt mercury vapor lights. Carried



Ed. Saurette-G.P.Goossen: That we authorize the purchase of an 8' step ladder, one 16' extension ladder and one Tapis Mat size 3'x5' for the Municipal Bldg. Carried

H.D.Earl-Ed.Saurette: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$78,341.50 be passed for payment. Carried
