

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. It was moved by Gib. Cretton, Seconded by Ben Klassen that the minutes of June 14th Council Meeting be adopted as read.

- Lettering on Office Doors H.D.Earl-WRecksiedler: That we accept the bids of Service Products for installing lettering on doors in the Municipal Building at a cost of \$97.65 and the bid of Wm. Dyck & Sons to cover downstairs walls with battens at \$192.00. Carried
- Amend Planning Scheme C.P.Goossen-H.D.Earl: That we request the Municipal Planning Branch to amend the Morris Planning Scheme 1968, in order to enlarge the General Commercial area in that portion of the Village of Rosenort bordered Red on the sketch attached, from a depth of 200 feet to a depth of 335.4 feet being South of the southern limit of Provincial Road #205. Carried
- Steinfeld-Lowe Farm consolidation. Ben Klassen-W.Recksiedler: That By-Law No. 969 providing for the dissolution of the Steinfeld S.D. #1128 and transferring its lands to the Consolidated School District of Lowe Farm, having received the approval of the Minister, be now read a third time and passed. Carried
- Members fees on Planning Commission E.Saurette-G.Goossen: That we reimburse our members on the Morris Planning Commission at \$5.00 per meeting and 10¢ a mile travelling ~~to~~ expense. Carried
- Carleton to Morris consolidation H.Earl-E.Saurette: That By-Law No. 976 being a by-law for the purpose of transferring all the lands of the Carleton S.D. No. 36 to the Morris Consolidated S.D. #2421 having been read a first time, be now read a second time and submitted to the Minister of Education for approval. Carried
- New Hydro contract-Street Lighting E. Saurette-G.Cretton: That By-Law No. 978, being a by-law for the purpose of rescinding By-Law No. 997 and approving draft contract between the Manitoba Hydro and the R.M. of Morris as per Schedule "A", having been read a first time, be now read a second and third time and passed. Carried
- Chain Saw W. Recksiedler-Ben Klassen: That we purchase one Chain Saw and accessories from Bronson Stevenson, Morris, for the price of \$267.44 Carried
- Adopting amended Planning Scheme G.P.Goossen-H.Earl: That By-Law No. 977 being a by-law for the purpose of adopting the Morris Planning Scheme 1968A, redesignating an area located in Rosenort from "A40" Rural District to "GC" General Commercial District, be given first ~~and second~~ reading and public notice thereof made in the Morris Journal. Carried
- Lowe Farm Nuisance Grounds Ben Klassen-G.Cretton: That we enter into an agreement with Julius Wiens of Lowe Farm for the purchase of 2 acres on Sec. SE 6-5-1W at \$300.00 an acre for use as a nuisance ground. Carried
- R.O.W. purchases "Boundary & "Lewis Drs. H. Earl-G.Goossen: That we appoint Lawrence Breyfogle to be our agent to purchase Right-of-Way along the "Boundary Drain" between the municipalities of Morris, Montcalm and Rhineland, as well as Right-of-Way along the "Lewis" Drain. The rate of pay for the agent at \$2.00 per hour and 10¢ a mile travelling expense. Carried
- Bridge 24-6-1E G.Goosson-G.Cretton: That we request the Water Control Branch to check on responsibility of the bridge on East side of Sec. 24-6-1E, as to a third order drain. Carried
- Accounts H.Earl-G.Goossen: That the accounts as approved byt the Finance Committee for \$28,645.60 be passed for payment. Carried
- Petition L. Parker A petition was presented by Lorne Parker and others requesting the deepening and improvement of the Township line ditch from PTH #75 to the NW corner of Section 33-6-2EPM(approx. 2½ miles). In attendance to discuss this matter were 16 ratepayers, the Reeve and Councillor from both the R.M. of Macdonald & R.M. of Ritchot, as well as three representatives from Water Control Branch. The matter will be investigated.

The meeting adjourned.
