L.Farm
Nuisance
Ground. | B. Klassen - W.Recksiedler: That By-Law No. 980, being a by-law for the purpose of purchasing certain property for a Nuisance Ground at Lowe Farm, be read a first time, read a second and third time and passed. | Carried |
| Additions
to Tax Roll | H. Earl - B.Klassen: That additions to the Tax Roll as listed in Exhibit "A" of the Provincial Assessor, dated August 19th, and covering Roll No's: 14, 431, 998, 2130 and 599D, be entered in the current Tax Roll and a demand for taxes mailed to the respective owners of these properties. East of
Morris
River. | G.P.Goossen-H.Earl: That we establish a restricted Speed Zone of 45 miles per hour on the road paralleling the East side of the Morris River and running from the North side of Rosenort to 2 miles South of Provincial Road 205. | Carried |

in Kane Vill | B. Klassen-G.Cretton: That we request the Highways Department to establish a speed zone of 45 miles per hour through the Village of Kane. | Carried |
| Alarm Siren
Rosenort | G. Goossen-H.Earl: That we authorize the purchase of one Alarm Siren (either Model M, single head siren or 2 H.P. Federal Siren) for the Village of Rosenort, depending on whichever is more more satisfactory to the Rosenort Fire Brigade. | Carried |

Burnett Drs. | G. Cretton-W.Recksiedler: That we ask the Water Control Branch for complete surveys on the "Brown" and "Burnett" drains. | Carried |
| Grant to
Agric.Soc. | H. Earl-W.Recksiedler: That we make a grant of \$1,000.00 to the Valley Agricultural Society and apply same to its indebtedness to the municipality. | Carried |

assistance | G. Cretton-W.Recksiedler: That we make application for assistance under Sec. 3 of the Prairie Farm Assistance Act for that area in our municipality marked on the attached map, which is estimated to yield less than 8 bushels on the average per acre. | Carried |
| Accounts | H. Earl- G.Goossen: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$55,555.68 be passed for payment. | Carried. |


No one attended the meeting to protest the transfer of the lands of Carleton S.D. to the Consolidated S.D. of Morris.
