The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. It was moved by B.Klassen, seconded by G.Cretton that the minutes of Sept. 13th meeting be adopted as read.

Harold Earl-G. Goossen: That payment of the balance of monies owing the contractor on the Municipal Building be withheld until the air conditioning unit is operating satisfactorily, as well as a few other items <sup>completing</sup> ~~which need completing.~~

W.F.Recksiedler-Gib. Cretton: That we submit the attached resolution re Second Order Drains to the Union of Manitoba Municipalities at the fall convention and circularize same among municipalities in the Red River area, prior to the convention.

Carried

Gib. Cretton-Ben Klassen: That we request the Highways Dept. to permit us to lower the culvert on West side of P.R.332 at the NE corner of Sec. 12-6-2WPM, and to install culverts on the West side of P.R. 332 at the SE corner 36-5-2W, and at the East side of P.R. 336 at the NW corner of Sec. 20-5-2 WPM.

Gib. Cretton-Harold Earl: That we appoint Wendall Fewster of Speeling as arbitrator re the petition of Levi Brandt et al, requesting the transfer of certain lands from the Morris Consolidated School District to the Rosenort Consolidated School District. (Sec. 306(3) M.A.)

George Goossen-H.D.Earl: That we request the Highways department to declare a speed zone through the Village of Rosenort on P.R. 205 of 30 Miles per Hour.

Carried

Ben Klassen-G.Cretton: That ~~the~~ Privaye Gravel be made available from our Municipal Pit on October 21, 22 and 23 to ratepayers of the municipality only, at \$1.30 a yard, loaded and crushed.

Ben Klassen-W.Recksiedler: That we approve of Board representation changes on the Altona Hospital District #24 as follows:

That the representation of the Rural Municipality of Montcalm be changed from Two members to One member on the Board  
and

That the representation of the Town of Altona be changed from One member to Two membrs on the Board.


Carried.


H. Earl- G. Goossen: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$130,915.41 be passed for payment.
