

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS
Morris, Man.

Nov. 8, 1968

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. It was moved by G.Cretton, Seconded by B.Klassen that the minutes of October 11th meeting be adopted as read.

H.H.Earl-Ben Klassen: That we pay the balance of money owing to London Construction Co. re the construction of the Municipal Building, except for a hold-back of \$500. until all deficiencies are corrected and an additional year's guarantee and bond is provided on the heating, air-conditioning and ventiating system. Carried

Ben Klassen-W.F.Recksiedler: That we authorize purchasing an Auxiliary Pump for the Lowe Farm Fire Brigade. Carried

W.F.Recksiedler-H.D.Earl: That we make a donation of \$20.00 to the Dr. F.L.Skinner Memorial Fund in honor of all the notable contributions made by him to the advancement of horticulture in the prairie provinces. Carried

G.P.Goossen-H.Earl: That we rescind the resolution of Sept. 13th establishing a speed zone of 45 miles an hour through Rosenort and replace same as follows:

That we establish a restricted Speed Zone of 45 miles an hour on the road paralleling the East side of the Morris River and running from the North side of Rosenort to 3 miles South of P.R. 205, except for that portion of the road through the village of Rosenort, which is restricted to a 30 mile an hour zone. Carried

Ben Klassen-W.F.Recksiedler: That we appoint Ben Bush of Morris as our Inspector to enforce the requirements of the Morris Planning Scheme in our municipality and that his fee in connection therewith be set at \$1.50 an hour and 10 cents a mile travelling expense. Carried

G. Cretton-H.Earl: In view of the depletion of Foxes in the municipality and an increase in the rabbit population (which foxes prey upon), be it resolved that no permits for fox hunting be issued in the 1968-1969 season. Carried

H.Earl-G.Goossen: That we request the Highways Dept. to declare the following Speed Zones: on Provincial Roads 246 and 205 through the Village of Aubigny a speed of 30 miles per hour. Carried

Gib Cretton-G.Goossen: That we authorize the Governing Board of the Carman Memorial Hospital District No. 20 to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of the Hospital Annex or other property (furnishings) subject to such terms and conditions as the Minister may deem advisable. Carried

H.D.Earl-W.Recksiedler: That each member of Council and a member of the Staff be allowed \$30.00 towards attending the Municipal Convention to be held in Winnipeg from Nov. 19th to the 21st and that the Hotel accomodations be paid by the municipality. Carried

G. Goossen-Gib Cretton: That we request the Water Control & Conservation Branch to assess the drainage problems on River Lots 402 to 450 and Sections 35 and 26 in Township 5, Range 2 East and to make recommendations for drainage works to relieve the flooding problems in this area, particularly River Lots 418 to 432. Carried

Harold Earl-G.Cretton: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$23,939.06 be passed for payment. Carried

Eleven ratepayers of Ward 4 attended the meeting to discuss drainage problems along River Lots 418 to 432. Various proposals were submitted. After a lengthy discussion it was decided to have this problem checked by the Water Control Branch. No promise could be made at this time as to when remedial action may be forthcoming.

George Schmidt of the firm of Slater & Braun, represented the Rosenort Community Centre Inc. (pending). The Community Centre is to be financed by pledges and donations from the people of the area. In order to have these donations, etc, declared as deductions for income tax purposes, they must be shown as donations to a representative of the Queen such as a Province or a Municipal Corporation. - The matter will receive the consideration of Council.

The Meeting adjourned.
