Earl-W.Recksiedler: That By-Law No. 984, being a by-law for the purpose of setting the date when taxes shall be due and payable in any year, and setting the penalty rate to be charged on taxes remaining unpaid after said due date, be read a first time, read a second and third time and passed. (Penalty 2/3% a month Due date - Oct. 31st) Carried
