## THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS Morris, Man.

APRIL 11, 1969

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. It was moved by G.P.Goossen, mSeconded by M.A.Caron that the minutes of March 17th meeting be adopetd as read.

Ben Klassen-Gib. Cretton: That we appoint John Martens of Morris, as our arbitrator re the petition of Edwin Nickel and others, praying for the consolidation of the n Horndean School District No. 820k with the Plum Coulee Consolidated School District. Carried

W.F.Recksiedler-B.Klassen: - That we make a grant m of \$25,00 to the International Peace Gardens.

Harold Earl-Marcel Caron: - That we ask our solicitor to prepare a by-law regulating the elevation for all new residences constructed that are not protected by the 1950 flood level;

also prepare a by-law to amend the Morris Planning Scheme to rezone Proposal #4 for Riverside subdivision from A-40 to R.A.

W.F.Recksiedler-G.P.Goossen: That By-Law No. 986 being a by-law for the purpose of controlling the parking, abandonment or leaving of "Derelict Vehicles" in the municipality, having been read a first time, be now read a second and third time and passed. Carried

B.Klassen-Harold Earl:- That we hire A.J.Kehler of Lowe Farm, as Weeds Mowing foremand for 1969. Carried

Gib. Cretton-G? Goossen: That we approve of the purchase of the following culverts and signs from n Westeel - Rosco:

72' of 15" - 18' culverts for Ward 5 and

12 Hazard Markers; 12 Yield signs and 24 sign posts. Carried

G. Cretton-W. Recksiedler: That we request the Highways Department to give early attention to completeing the Access Road from PTH #3 to Main Street in the Village of Sperling.

Harold Earl-M.A.Caron: That we agree to assume all survey costs exceeding \$25.00 per parcel, on that portion of NE 20-5-1 E.P.M. known as Riverside Drive, and authorize the firm of "Wilson, Hayward and Neal" to complete said survey. Carried

H. Farl-M. Caron: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$51,380.50 be passed for payment.

The R. M. of Dufferin was to be notified that its share of the costs for the reconstruction of the "Lewis" & "Brown" drains for 1969, is estimated to be im from \$5,000. to \$6,000.

The Water Control Branch has indicated that it plans to complete the reconstruction of the "Forrester" & "Kronsgart" drains this year.

A delegation of 11 ratepayers, headed by K?. McLean, attended the meeting requesting a clean-out or reconstruction of the "Brown" drain.

Council agreed to enter for 1969, the farm of Eddie 7. Friesen, situate on S.W. 32-5-1 E.P.M. in the Best Farm Home Grounds competition, sponsored by the Manitoba Good Roads Association.

The meeting adjourned.
