H. Earl-M.A.Caron: That we set a rate of \$10.00 for use of the Parking Lot and Electric Plug-ins for vehicles, during the 1969/70 winter season.

W.Recksiedler-B.Klassen: That we purchase one used Compresser from Jack Hamblin, Morris, for \$125.00. Carried
