## RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS Morris, Man.

March 13, 1970

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date, with all members present. It was moved by Harold Earl, seconded by M.A.Caron, that the minutes of February 13th council meeting be adopted.

Ben Klassen-Gib. Cretton:

That we authorize members of Council, members of the Municipal Planning Scheme and the Secretary-Treasurer to attend the "Planning Smeintar" to be held in n Winnipeg, on Thursday, April 16th and that expenses connected therewith be paid by the municipality. Carried

M. A. Caron-Ben Klassen: That we authorize the various Equipment Companies to sell our American Dragline at a net price of \$7,500.00 Carried

Harold Earl-Geo. Goossen: That we contract with Johnny Dueck, Rosenort, to truck, load and crush our road gravel requirements for 1970 at the following rates:-

> Hauling at 82 cents a yard per mile, Crushing and Loading on trucks at 60 cents a yard.

W. F. Recksiedler-G.M.Cretton: That we have Andre Marion, Weeds Supervisor, co-ordinate our Weeds Program for 1970 and pay his mileage expense connected Carried therewith.

Ben Klassen-M.A.Caron: That we purchase the following used Steel Tanks from Lowe Farm Consumets Co-op. Ltd.:-

2 - 500 gallon and toes three 300 gallon Tanks at \$50.00 each. Carried

Gib Cretton-W.F.Recksiedler: That we request the Highways Department to complete the Access Road from P.T.H. #2 to Main Street in the Village of Sperling.

That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$11,491.96 be passed for payment.

Canadian Pacifics Railways forwarded an application for leave to remove Agents at variousk locations, including Morris and replacing same through a "Customer Service Centre at Brandon". No objection was to be made by our municipality.

Members from the Rosenort Chamber of Commerce appeared with a request that the R.M. of Morris obtain title to the property proposed for a Centennial Park at Rosenort. This matter was to be referred to our municipal legal advisor.

Reports were heard from our delegates to the Brandon Convention held March 4 & 5th. Ben Klassen and W.F. Recksiedler stated that the main subject matter had been drainage problems, water pollution etc.

Some discussion arose regarding a Permit System regarding the erection of buildings in the municipality. What type of Permit and what fees to charge. Further dis investigation to be made.
