The Rural Municipality of Morris AUGUST 14, 1970

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The minutes of July 10th meeting were adopted upon motion by B.Klassen and G.P.Goossen.

Aug. 6-

W.F.Recksiedler-Ben Klassen: Whereas it was previous practice of the Highways Department to mow Provincial road allowances,

And Whereas a serious weed problem exists on many Provincial roads in our municipality, causing grave concern to the farmers whose fields adjoin said roads;

Now therefor, the Council requests the Highways department to resume mowing its road allowances, as in the past, and instigate said policy immediately.

Gilbert Cretton-W.F.Recksiedler: That By-Law No. 1002 being a by-law for the purpose of borrowing monies from the Bank of Montreal in the amount of \$75,000.00, if required, to meet current expenditures of the corporation for the year 1970, having been read a first time, be now read a second and third time and passed.

H.D.Earl-G.Cretton: That By-Law No. 1003 being a by-law for the purpose of enetering into a Planning Service Agreement with the Municipal Affairs Department, having been read a first time, be now read a second and third time and passed.

Ben Klassen-W. Recksiedler: That we grant the Valley Agricultural Society the sum of \$1,000.; said amount to be applied as a reduction of them society's indebtedness to the municipality.

M.A.Caron-G.P.Goossen: That we instruct surveyors Wilson, Neil and Hayward to survey that portion taken for right-of-way on drain, on River Lots 434 and 436.

G.P.Goossen-H.D.Earl: That we make application to the Minister to establish a "Resource Conservation District" of the entire area of the municipality of Morris. (Bill 53). (Control of the removal of trees along natural Waterways.)

Ben Klassen-W. Recksiedler: That we order one set of the 1970 Revised Statutes of Manitoba and a book case for same.

H.D.Earl-M.A.Caron: Whereas the Minister of Health has submitted to the municipality of Morris Schemes providing for the inclusion of the Village of Plum Coulee in the Southern Health and Laboratory & X-Ray Unit No. 5;

Therefore by it resolved that the Rural Municipality of Morris approve the Schemes submitted as aforesaid and the inclusion of the Village of Plum Coulee in the Southern Health and Laboratory & X-Ray Unit No. 5.

M.A.Caron-G.P.Goossen: That Alice Loving be declared Acting Secretary-Treasurer during the absence of the Clerk, while he is on halidays from August 27th to September 10th, 1970, and shall, while she fills this office, have all the powers and perform all the duties of the Clerk. (Sec. 346, Municipal Act.)

G. Cretton-M.Caron: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$28,250.33 be passed for payment.
