

H. D. Earl-Ben Klassen:


That the annual estimates of all amounts required for the lawful purposes of the municipality for operating expenditures for 1971, including all amounts required to pay debts of the municipality becoming due and payable during that year, as well as all amounts it will require to expend in that year for capital purposes and the amount of any revenue deficit or over-expenditure made in the last year, be adopted (Sec. 560(4) and 561(3) Municipal Act., and first reading given By-Law No. 1013 levying taxes for 1971.

H.D.Earl-Ben Klassen:

That the Capital expenditure program for the five years following 1971, setting out the priorities in the proposed capital expenditure and the estimate of source of funds to implement the program, be adopted.
