That we request the Department of Public Works and Highways to have the streets in the villages of "Aubigny", "Lowe Farm", "Rosenort" and "Sperling", designated a "grant-in-aid street system".

W.F.Recksiedler-Ben Klassen:

That we request the Municipal Planning Branch of the Municipal Affairs Dept. to re-zone from "A Rural" to "M 2", that portion of the Morris Planning Scheme described as follows:

"Being all that portion of the most southerly Two Hundred (200) feet in perpendicular depth of River Lot 323 Three hundred & twenty Three, of the Parish of Ste. Agathe, in Manitoba, according to a plan of same registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 3799, lying between the Eastern limit of a Public Road as said is shewn on a plan deposited in the said office as No. 4943, and the Western limit of the Lord Selkirk Highway as said Highway is shewn on said Plan No. 3799.

A proposed plan of subdivision of part of SW 8-5-1 EPM as presented by Franklin Plett, Rosenort, was given careful study; mm approval was not made at this time, as mentain a certain street on said plan did not appear to have the width deemed desirable for this subdivision. Further investigation will be made.
