SPECIAL MEETING

W. F. Recksiedler-Ben Klassen:

That By-Law No. 1020 being a by-law for the purpose of borrowing monies from the Bank of Montreal in the amount of \$125,000, if required, to meet current expenditures, be read a first, second and third time and passed;

And further more, that by-law No. 1012 dated April 8th, 1971, being a by-law for a similar purpose, be and hereby is rescinded.

Ben Klassen-Gib Cretton: That we tender for 50 gallons of glycol base Anti Freeze in one gallon containers, for immediate delivery, F.O.B. Morris.

Tenders to be in the hands of the Secretary-Treasurer by Sept. 27th, 1971, at 12 noon.

G.P.Goossen-M.A.Caron: That we pay Alice Loving \$100.00 for typing and preparing the 1971 List of Electors, as is required by Sec 31(2) of the Municipal Act;

and that surplus copies of said list be sold at \$1.00 per copy to nonelectors of the municipality.

Ben Klassen-W.F.Recksiedler: That we assign Tax Sale Certificate no. 12/70, to J.G.Swain of Sperling, upon receipt of \$319.69, being the amount for which the land was sold at tax sale, plus subsequent taxes to December 31, 1971.

It was decided to send the following resolution to the Union of Manitoba Municipalities for its consideration at the annual convention to be held in November:

Re: \$50.00 Tax Rebate:-

WHEREAS the fact is well recognized that real property presently bears a greater than equitable share of the burden of school costs, and it has been the stated intention of the Government of Manitoba to resolve this inequity;

AND WHEREAS the recently introduced \$50.00 school tax rebate applies only to the property on which a ratepayer resides and will therefore result in a greater school tax reduction, percentagewise, for the purely residential owner than for the ratepayer who earns his living from the land, and therefore a greater inequity;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Government of Manitoba find some more equitable means of easing the tax burden on real property.
