## Sept. 8, 1972

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. It was moved by G.M.Cretton and seconded by G.P.Goossen that the minutes of August 11th council meeting be adopted as read.

W.F.Recksiedler-Ben Klassen: That we request the Water Control Branch to supply us with levels on the drain through the centre of 29-4-2WPM, as well as on the East side of said section 29-4-2WPM.

Ben Klassen-W.F.Recksiedler: Whereas culverts have been removed upstream on the "Kronsgart Drain" and larger bridges have replaced same, We request the Water Control Branch to enlarge the bridge a t NE 1-4-2 WPM in order to prevent flooding of the farm yard at this location.

G.M. Cretten-Ben Klassen: That By-Law No. 1033, providing for the taking of a vote of the electors to approve the issue of certain classes of licenses for the sale of liquor in resepct of primises in The Rural Municipality of Morris, having been read a first time, be read assecond time and third time and passed.

Sec. 183(2) of the Municipal Act was suspended in this case.

G.P.Goossen-A.K.Fast: That Ey-Law No. 1034 being a by-law for the purpose of adopting the 1971 Electors List for the year 1972, having been read a first time, be mead a second and third time and passed. Sec. 183(2) of the Municipal Act was suspended.

Marcel Caren-A.K.Fast: That By-Law No. 1035, reducing the time allotted for the Revising Officer to sit for the purpose of revising the Electors List, to one day, be read a first, second and third time and passed. Sec 183(2) of the Municipal Act be suspended.

Ben Klassen-M.A.Caron: That we authorize a grant of \$131.60 to the Riverview Golf Club and apply this amount to its indebtadness to the municipality, for the use of municipal max equipment on the course.

G.P.Goossen-G.M.Cretton: Whereas Land Titles Office will not accept our application for title with respect to Tax Sale Certificate 11/70, covering part of the SW and NW of Sec. 29-6-2W, registered under Deed 43347 and CT36642;

Therefore be it resolved that TSC 11/70 for \$8.39, as well as TSC 12/71 for \$32.58 be redeemed from Tax Sale (Sec. 839(1), and said parcels assessed to its respective quarter sections.

W.F.Recksiedler-Ben Klassen: That the treasurer shall add to the 1972 Tax Roll those items listed by the assessor in Exhibit "A" dated the 31st day of August, 1972.

M.A.Caron-G.Goossen: That we report the wheat acreage yield in our municipality to be averaging from 20 to 25 bushels to the acre as at Sept. 1, 1972 and submit said report to the Prairie Farm Assistance Act, Regins.

Ben Klassen-A.K.Fast: That the accounts as examined by council and approved by the Finance Committee for \$47,594.29 be passed for payment.

A.K.Fast-M.A.Caron: That the applications of the following ratepayers, requesting to have dwelling units recorded in the Tax Roll for purpose of School Tax Reduction, be approved:
