

Minutes of
RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS
April 11, 1974

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The minutes of March 8th council meeting were adopted upon motion of G.M.Cretton, seconded by Alvin Rempel.

W.F.Recksiedler-A.K.Fast: Whereas Tax Sale Certificate #2, 1972 covering E'ly 20 rds of W'ly 105 rods of S'ly 16 rods of SW 22-4-1E, was improperly advertised and should have read:

the e'ly 20 rds of W'ly 105 rds of

S'ly 16 rds of the SW 22-4-1 WPM

No therefor be it resolved that Tax Sale Certificate #2, 1972 sold for \$14.67, be redeemed from Tax Sale. Sec. 839(1).

A.K.Fast-G.M.Cretton: That Lien No. 130792, dated Dec. 21, 1959 and filed against P.R.Friesen in the amount of \$88.00 be discharged at no cost.

M.A.Caron-Alvin Rempel: That By-Law No. 1056 being a by-law for the purpose of withdrawing from the provisions of respecting the Triennial Elections of all members of Council be read a first, second and third time and passed. Sec. 183(2) of the Municipal Act be suspended.

M.A.Caron-A.K.Fast: That By-law No. 1057 for the purpose of opening a public road in River Lots 501 and 503 of the Parish of Ste Agathe be read a first, second and third time and passed. Sec 183(2) of the Municipal Act was suspended.

W.F.Recksiedler-B.A.Wiebe: That By-Law No. 1058 being for the purpose of selling a portion of River Lot 432, Plan 4116, consisting of about 2 acres, to Yves Guillou of Aubigny, for \$200.00, be read a first, second and third time and passed. Sec. 183(2) of the Act was suspended.

M.A.Caron-W.Recksiedler: That we subscribe to a $\frac{1}{4}$ page ad in the Morris Collegiate Year Book.

A. K. Fast-W.F.Recksiedler: That we appoint the following delegates to attend the annual meeting of the Branch Lines Association to be held at Brandon on April 22nd, 1974:

G.M.Cretton - M.Caron: That we order 1 white and 6 yellow Hard Hats from Safety Supply Co..

Ben A. Wiebe - Alvin Rempel: That we authorize the closing of the office ~~from~~^{on} May 6th, 7th, and 8th, while the office staff is attending the Annual Convention and course in Municipal Administration of the Manitoba Municipal Secretary-Treasurers' Association and the expenses connected therewith be paid by the municipality.

M.A.Caron - G.M.Cretton: Whereas Sec. 115(1) of the Municipal Act requires that the Council of each municipality organize its first meeting on the 14th day next following the day on which the election was held,

And Whereas the fiscal year of our municipality ends on December 31st of each year;


