

The Rural Municipality of Morris

May 10, 1974

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held ~~an~~ ^{its regular} ~~Special~~ Meeting on the above date with the following members present:
Reeve Harold Earl, Councillors W.F.Recksiedler, Alvin Rempel, Marcel Caron, Benjamin Wiebe and Gilbert Cretton.

G.M.Cretton-B.A.Wiebe: That the minutes of April 11th and those of May 1st meetings be adopted as read.

Another request by J.J.Toews, Kane to support a second private members bill re the apportionment of school levies of the Kane Cons. S.D. was discussed;

It was moved by B.A.Wiebe, seconded by G.M.Cretton that we do not support a private members bill (No.2) which would require the Morris-Macdonald S.D. #19 to levy and pay such amounts and to such persons as may be determined by the Municipal Board re the apportionment of Annual School Levies for the years 1967, 1968 and 1969.

M.A.Caron-W.F.Recksiedler: That By-law No. 1059 being a by-law for the purpose of redesignating an area from "A40" Rural District to "RA" Suburban District, more fully described as:

an area located at Rosenort on the north side of PR 205, being part of SW 8-6-1EPM, east of and adjacent to a Registered Plan #11395, this area lying within the dyke, having been approved by the Advisory Commission of the Morris Planning Scheme, be given first reading and the necessary advertising proceeded with.

Alvin Rempel-G.M.Cretton: Resolved that plan of subdivision of part of SW 8-6-1 EPM prepared by Hans Neumann, Manitoba Land Surveyor, be and the same is hereby approved for registration.

The Mayor of the Town of Emerson requested support to the following resolution: "That the Government, Prov. of Manitoba, will be prepared to pay full costs of all sand bags, sand and rented pumps and the cost of building any temporary dyke";

At this date government flood policy had already been announced, which covered this request.

An invitation to the Annual Meeting of the Prairie Flood Control organization at Brandon, May 17th was received. Speakers will deal with the effects of the proposed "Garrison Diversion".

W.Recksiedler-B.A.Wiebe: That we order the following culverts/ from Armco Drainage: 1 - 14" culvert 30"
1 - 16" culvert 30"
2 - 12" culverts 30" and 2 couplers for same.

M.A.Caron-G.M.Cretton: That we request the Highways Department to:
1. Upgrade the low areas on P.R. 246 from PIH #23 to P.R. #200;
2. Upgrade the low areas on PR #205 from Rosenort to Sperling.
3. Upgrade the low areas on PR #523 between mile 2 and Mile 3.

Alvin Rempel-B.A.Wiebe: That the accounts as examined by Council and approved by the Finance Committee for \$36,021.13 be passed for payment.

Reeve Harold Earl presented council members with a comprehensive report on Flood Control Activities in the municipality. As he stated in this report: --- "it is written, partly in defence of the criticism levelled at municipal people for their lack of preparedness but more as a record to be used to improve our E.M.O. Flood Fighting Plan".

A Special meeting was set for May 14th at 1 p.m. subject matters- Grasshopper Control, Operators Wages, Insurance, Flood Reports.

The meeting adjourned.
