SPECIAL MEETING

JUNE 18/74

9 p.m.

Council met in special session on the above date with all members, excepting Ben Wiebe, in attendance.

The Grasshopper policy for 1974 was the main subject under discussion. It was agreed that each councillor be appointed the coordinator for his ward and arrange for local farmers to spray chemicals on road allowances and drainage ditches. Each councillor will receive a supply of chemical, and after assessing the need for spraying, direct the applicator to spray these areas. An initial order of 500 gallons of chemical was ordered immediately.

Due to a 12% increase in the price of culverts, it was agreed to place the following order prior to the increase taking affect; Armco Canada Ltd and Westeel-Rosco Ltd: (identical quantity)-

Councillor Ben Wiebe was appointed to have the municipal float in readiness for the "Shannon Festival" parade to be held on Saturday, June 22nd.


Municipal mowers were to start mowing in villages, starting with the Village of Lowe Farm. A.K. Fast to co-ordinate this program.
