

The Rural Municipality of Morris

August 9, 1974 - 9 a.m.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The minutes of July 12th meeting were read and adopted on motion of M.A.Caron and W.F.Recksiedler.

G.Cretton moved, seconded by W.Recksiedler that we grant the Valley Agricultural Society the sum of \$850.00, said amount to be applied towards its indebtedness to the municipality for services performed during the 1974 stampede and exhibition.

Alvin Rempel - A.K.Fast: That By-law No. 1059 being a by-law for the purpose of amending the Morris Planning Scheme by redesignating part of SW 8-6-1 EPM from A40 to RA suburban district, having been duly advertised and no objections received, be now read a second and third time and passed.

W.F.Recksiedler-G.M.Cretton: That we advertise the following used equipment for sale:

G.M.Cretton-Alvin Rempel : Whereas the Advisory Commission of the Morris Planning Scheme has approved a request of Ken Wadell, Sperling to rezone Part of SW 29-6-2 WPM from A40 to RA as per plan attached;

Be it resolved that the municipality concurs with this decision, provided subdivided lots are 20,000 square feet in area as required by the Morris Planning Scheme.

W.Recksiedler-B.A.Wiebe: That we order the following culverts from Armco Drainage:

Two 20' lengths of 48" culverts with one coupler, to be delivered to NE 7-4-2 WPM via Bens Transfer. *Cancelled - Reordered by order Sept 4/74*

Each Councillor was to revise the Voters' List in readiness for elections coming up in October.

A letter of thanks was to be forwarded to Premier Edward Schreyer for being instrumental in having the north approach to the Morris River bridge on P.T.H. #75 raised and black-topped.

The Secretary was instructed to order six Municipal Acts for use by the Council.

Several members of Council expressed interest in taking part in the Regional Agricultural Tour which will leave Morris (Burke's) at 7:30 a.m. on Thursday, August 15th, 1974.

Council was invited to join in discussion regarding establishing 2 acre residential lots in the municipality. A meeting for this purpose will be held in the Council Chambers at 8 p.m. on Fri. Sept. 6th. with members of the Advisory Commission of the Morris Planning scheme and representatives of the Municipal Planning Branch, Winnipeg.

Council was informed that public hearing with regard to flood protection and flood fighting will be held in late fall or early winter, as per letter from the Manitoba Water Commission.

Council was also informed that when a vehicle on a Provincial Highway catches fire and the municipality incurs the expense of attending the fire, claims for costs involved will receive favourable consideration by Manitoba Public Insurance Corporation.

Moved by Alvin Rempel, seconded by M.A.Caron that the accounts as examined by Council and approved by the Finance Committee for \$35,496.69 be passed for payment.
