A Special Meeting was held on the above date for the purpose of considering the purchase of a Motor Grader with snow-plowing equipment. All members of Council were present.

Reeve Harold Earl informed council of the Equipment committees efforts to find a plow for one of our graders. In this search a complete grader unit with snow-plow was considered. Some of the prices obtained during this consideration were:

1972 Gallion Grader (hydraulic with about 2600 hours of operation (without plow)..... \$35,000

Powell Equipt. - snow plow only 2,300.

Huggard Equipt.- Complete unit 43,000.
plus 1 use Omaha V Plow..... 200.

After considerable deliberations it was moved by A.K.Fast, seconded by M.A.Caron: That we purchase one new 1974 Model D562 C hampion Motor Grader, equipped with:

ROPS Cab, heater, defroster, windshield wipers, lights,
West Coast Mirrors, 14' moldboard, 14:00x24, 12 PR tires
Symmer/Winter air control; Power tilt and Power Slide
on moldboard; 4-wheel brakes;
"A" Frame and 9 ft plow with down pressure;
Rear mounted wing less blade; 20 gal Hyd. Pump.
Powered by Waukesha-Scania Model F475D, 6 cyl;
4 cy. engine 138 HP at 2000 RPM.

USED OMAHA Plow with mounting brackets
and cylinder;


The new Champion Grader to carry a 2 year company warranty.
