At 11 A.M., Sunday, April 22, 1979, Premier Sterling Lyon, held a meeting in the Legislative Building, Winnipeg, with representatives from all Municipalities in the Flood Area, to discuss the 1979 Flood forecast.

At 3 P.M., Sunday, April 22, 1979, The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held a Special Meeting, in the Council Chambers at the Town of Morris, to discuss, and organize for the predicted Flood. Reeve Alvin Rempel presided, and Councillors present were Wm. F. Recksiedler, A. K. Fast, Norman Wiens, George St. Hilaire, Dan Thiessen, and Gilbert Cretton. Councillor Wiens recorded the minutes of the Special Meeting.

- . Gilbert Cretton was appointed representative for the Sperling Area.
- . Alvin Rempel was appointed representative for the Rosenort Area.
- . 24 Hour Watch,- Rosenort Area is to have A. K. Fast, Norman Wiens, and George St. Hilaire, to man the office, with wards overlapping.
- . Radio Stations C.F.A.M., and C.F.R.Y., are to be notified and asked to announce phone numbers.
- . E.M.O. will look after sand bagging of grain on site where required.
- . Railway grain cars are being asked for by E.M.O.
- . We need a co-ordinator of sand delivery. The municipal man, on shift, is to co-ordinate delivery.
- . 100,000 bags have been ordered by E.M.O., and this should be sufficient for present needs.
- . Every Council Member should keep a log of orders, and authorization of requests.


The following need to be notified to move cattle to the 1950 flood level prediction: Lorne Lewis, Ralph Eidse, Bob Swain.
