

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

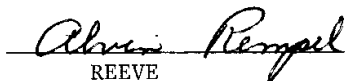
The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held a meeting beginning at 10:15 A.M., on Tuesday, June 26, 1979, in the Council Chambers at the Town of Morris with Reeve Alvin Rempel presiding. Present were: Councillors: - Wm. F. Recksiedler, A. K. Fast, Norman Wiens, George St. Hilaire, Dan Thiessen, and Gilbert Cretton; and Secretary-Treasurer Alice Loving.


- Manitoba Flood Disaster Assistance Board Forms for assistance, Report re meeting held with Premier on June 21. The forms from the Manitoba Flood Disaster Assistance Board, for application for increased grants for moving and raising or terracing flood damaged buildings, were discussed. Gilbert Cretton reported on the meeting held, on June 21st., in Winnipeg, with Premier Sterling Lyon, E.M.O., the Manitoba Flood Disaster Assistance Board, various M.L.A.'s, plus representatives from the Municipalities, and Towns in the flooded area. At that time the estimate for moving and raising in the flood plain was 8½ million. Raising roads in the flooded areas was discussed, as well as improving flood forecasting. The Federal Government wants restrictions on buildings in the Valley, and the Province will discuss tighter municipal planning and zoning. Approximately 2,400 flood applications had been received, with 40 claims being processed a day. It was decided that the Secretary-Treasurer could sign the above mentioned Flood Claim Forms, if the Councillor has signed a Building Application.
- Hog Finishing Barn. The Municipal Notification Form from the Environmental Control Branch regarding the Hog Finishing Barn for Ralph Eidse, on Section 29, Township 5, Range 1E.P.M., was acknowledged, and Secretary-Treasurer authorized to sign same.
- Minutes. Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by George St. Hilaire: #121/79. Resolved that the minutes of the meeting held June 14, 1979, be adopted as read. Carried.
- New Hourly Rates re Bridge Gang, and Mower Operators. Councillor Wiens, Chairman of Relations Committee stated the complaints of the Bridge Crew. Moved by G. M. Cretton, Seconded by Norman Wiens: #122/79. Resolved that we adjust the Bridge Crew and Mower Operator Salaries, as follows:

Bridge Foreman	\$6.05 per Hour;
Assistant Bridge Foremen	5.60 per Hour;
Laborers	5.50 per Hour;
Mower Operators and Tree Planter	6.00 per Hour.

 Above rates to be retro-active to the pay period beginning February 5, 1979. Carried.
- Reimbursement re Grasshopper Spray. Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by Wm. F. Recksiedler: #123/79. Resolved that we reimburse farmers for spraying for grasshoppers, on the road allowances, if approved by the various Ward Councillors. This is for chemical only. Carried.
- Trailer for Bridge Truck. Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by A. K. Fast: #124/79, Resolved that we purchase a flat deck trailer, triple axle, for the Bridge Truck, from Conrad's Sand & Soil of Headingley, for \$2,000.00. Carried.
- History Book Typing @ \$5.50 per hr. Moved by Norman Wiens, Seconded by George St. Hilaire: #125/79. Resolved that we pay \$5.50 per hour for the typing on the R.M. of Morris Centennial History Book. Carried.
- Flood Bills. The Flood Bills were reviewed by all members of Council. Several were left with the Secretary-Treasurer to obtain more information, so that they could be paid at the next meeting.
- By Law #1117-Road Closing-Goossen Drive read a second time. Moved by Wm. F. Recksiedler, Seconded by A. K. Fast: #126/79. Whereas By Law #1117, being a By Law, for the purpose of closing a road on the NW 5-6-1E, taken for Goossen Drive, was introduced, and read a first time on the 11th day of January, 1979; Now Therefore Be It Resolved that By Law #1117, be read a second time, to be submitted to the Minister of Mines and Resources, for approval. Carried.

- By Law #1122, - Development Agreement with Rosenort Development Corporation read a second and third time. Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by George St. Hilaire: #127/79. Whereas By Law #1122, being a By Law, for the purpose of entering into a Development Agreement with the Rosenort Development Corporation, was introduced, and read a first time on the 17th day of May 1979; Now Therefore Be It Resolved that By Law #1122 be read a second and third time, signed by the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer, sealed with the Corporate Seal, and finally passed. Carried.
- Mrs. Marion receives \$300 for cleaning. Moved by George St. Hilaire, Seconded by Norman Wiens: #128/79. Resolved that we pay Mrs. Therese Marion extra hours for cleaning municipal building, to restore to pre flood condition, as - 75 hours @\$4.00 per hour= \$300.00. Carried.
- And \$375.00 per month in July. Moved by Norman Wiens, Seconded by George St. Hilaire: #129/79. Resolved that we pay the Caretaker, Mrs. Therese Marion \$375.00 per month, beginning with July, 1979. Carried.
- Purchase of a Coupler. Moved by Norman Wiens, Seconded by A. K. Fast: #130/79. Resolved that we purchase a coupler for either a 72, or 84 inch culvert; And install culvert at NE corner of 35-5-1E. Carried.
- Purchases for Float. Moved by George St. Hilaire, Seconded by Norman Wiens: #131/79. Resolved that the Float Committee be authorized to make purchases for the making of a Float for the Stampede Parade. Carried.
- Gravel- 6-5-2W, 8-6-1E. Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by Norman Wiens: #132/79. Resolved that ½ mile of gravel be placed on the East side of Section 6-5-2W; And 1 mile of gravel on the East mile of Section 8-6-1E. Carried.
- Zoning Memorandum- NW 5-6-1E. approved. Moved by Norman Wiens, Seconded by A. K. Fast: #133/79. Resolved that a Zoning memorandum can be prepared for the NW of Section 5-6-1E - Lot 5, as all buildings were in existance when the Morris Planning Scheme began and so conforms to the said plan. Carried.
- History Book Meeting. It was decided to call a meeting of Council, with Mr. R. A. Cringan, and the History Book Committee, at 7:30 P.M., Friday, July 6, 1979. Delegation: Barry Stevenson attended to discuss property that could be used to relocate his shop.
- Communications: -
1. Ken Waddell - Offer to purchase the lot on the SW 29-6-2W, for \$100.00.- Agreeable if ^{he} pays for the legal work to prepare the By Laws, and Transfer of Sale.
 2. Sperling Community Club- Planning Committee.-Notification of their Board of Directors, and the organizational meeting. Request for a resolution of approval of their project, and a guarantee of operating funds. - Table for Legal Advice.
- Relations Committee Report. Councillor Wiens, Chairman of Relations Committee, gave a report regarding the Relations Committee recommendations concerning Holiday Pay (Dates to be planned in advance), Storm Pay (No work, no Pay); Pension Plan, Blue Cross. It was felt that a meeting with all employees should be held, tentative date -during November.
- Adjournment. The meeting adjourned at 6:40 P.M. The next regular meeting will be held on Thursday, July 12, 1979, at 10 A.M.
