The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held a Special Meeting at 7:45 P.M., on Thursday, August 16, 1979, in the Council Chambers at the Town of Morris, to discuss the following:

- . Sperling Community Centre;
- . Using and Raising Roads for Dykes;
- . Gravel request for the North side of the Shannon Dyke.

All Council Members had been duly notified, orally.

Bernhard Gehring, Charles Peckover, and W. J. Fewster, regarding the Sperling Rink.

Solicitor Stan Braun, was also in attendance.

The question of Life Memberships, to raise money for the building of the Community Centre, was the question.

Mr. Braun explained that if the Centre was to be owned by the Municipality, there could be no restriction of the use of the facility to any ratepayer, because he did not belong to the Club., in other words it would have to be unincumbered. There could not be any preference to the owner of the "Life Membership", or any deferential made.

It was suggested that the Secretary-Treasurer look into the possibility of arranging a meeting with the Municipal Department, the Rural Municipality of Dufferin, and the Rural Municipality of Macdonald, to discuss the Community Centre.

Dyking

The dyking of Roads was discussed. The majority felt that they were not prepared to sanction such a policy, and agreed to pass a resolution regarding same, at the next Council Meeting.

Gravel

Reeve Alvin Rempel announced that the Council would now sit in Camera, and Mrs. Shewchuk left the meeting.


The discussion was the request for gravel on  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile of the Shannon Dyke, therefore Councillor Thiessen left the meeting also.
