Whereas By Law No. 1128, being a By Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris, ratifying and confirming the exclusions of areas, and the establishment of further hospital facilities regarding the Carman Memorial Hospital District No. 20, was introduced and read a first time on September 13, in 1979; And Whereas we have now received Order No. F 212/79, of the Municipal Board which ratifies the Supplementary Scheme; Now Therefore Be It Resolved that By Law No. 1128 be read a second, and third time, signed by the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer, sealed with the corporate seal, and finally passed.
