

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held a Special Meeting at 9:15 A.M., on FRIDAY, JULY 18, 1980, in the Council Chambers at the Town of Morris with Reeve Alvin Rempel presiding. Present were Councillors: - Wm. F. Recksiedler, Norman Wiens, George St. Hilaire, Dan Thiessen, and Gilbert Cretton, and Secretary-Treasurer, Alice Loving.

The meeting had been called by the Reeve, and the Secretary-Treasurer had notified all Council Members of same, orally, as well as inform them that the meeting would be about dyking on roads.

It was noted that each situation would have different circumstances, and that Council should have a reason why one individual was allowed to dyke, while another was not.


Committee of Drainage, and Road Chairman and Ward Councillor to investigate requests for dyke. Moved by Norman Wiens, Seconded by G. M. Cretton: #183/80. Whereas the Rural Municipality of Morris Council has received numerous requests to allow road allowances and roads to be used as part of dyking for flood protection; Now Therefore BE It Resolved that a Committee, consisting of the Chairman of Drainage, the Chairman of Roads, and the Councillor of the Ward from which the request originates be given the power to either approve requests with conditions, as they see fit, or deny the request. FOR:3, AGAINST: 2. Carried.

Dykes not approved to be removed. Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by George St. Hilaire: #184/80. Resolved that any dykes built on road allowances not built to specifications or approved by the Council be removed at the owners cost. Carried.

Guidelines for Dyking Committee. Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by George St. Hilaire: #185/80. Resolved that the following Guidelines be used by the "Dyking for Flood Protection Committee: - 1. Top of road a minimum of 22 Feet Wide; 2. No interference of (a) Drainage, (b) Traffic Flow, (c) Snow Removal; 3. Three to One Slope, with Back Slope; 4. Gravel of 300 Yards to a mile, if gravel is involved. Carried.

Adjournment. The Special Meeting adjourned at 11:10 A.M., the next regular meeting to be held AUGUST 14, 1980, at 10 A.M.
