The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held a meeting, at 7:45 P.M., on Tuesday, October 14, 1980, in the Council Chambers at the Town of Morris with Reeve Alvin Rempel presiding. Present were Councillors: - Wm. F. Recksiedler, Anton K. Fast, George St. Hilaire, Dan Thiessen, and Gilbert Cretton, and Secretary-Treasurer, Alice Loving.

Also in attendance, Mrs. Barbara Shewchuk, Reporter, Scratching River Post.

A delegation of Levi Brandt, Frank Dueck, and Dick Zacharias, presented aerial pictures to Council, and proposed a high level road south of Rosenort. They had an audience with the Flood Board today, and said they could obtain help from them, plus would raise money through donations, and wanted financial help from the Municipality to complete the project. The road would be raised to the approximate height of P.R. #205.

After the delegation left, the Sperling Rink was discussed.

Members re Joint Sperling Community Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by George St. Hilaire: #235/80. Resolved that Wendal J. Fewster, and Gilbert Cretton be appointed to the Joint Community Centre District, for Sperling.

It was decided to contact Lawyer C. Chappell regarding the guidelines, functions, and authority of the Board. Answers for the following items were also to be obtained:

(a) Would the funds already raised be placed in the trust of the Rural Municipality of Morris;

(b) Preparation of the agreement, to be signed by the Rural Municipalities, and the Committee;

(c) Can the \$32,000.00 Foregiveness Loan be advanced to the Municipality;

(d) Can the Committee keep any monies not spent.

The Centennial History Book, "Furrows in the Valley" was discussed. The Committee mailed letters to all individuals who placed partial payments, with the Municipality, for the Book, stating the balance owing, and that the book could be obtained at the Legion Hall on October 18, 1980. Posters have also been put up throughout the

As it is not feasible to take Municipal Records out of the Office, to the Legion Hall, to collect the partial payments of the Book, the Secretary-Treasurer suggested that if Council wished to sell books, as the Book Committee had already advertised, that an Officer, or Officers, be appointed by By Law, to be responsible for the Collection on the said day.

By Law No. 1144, appointee to be responsible for Book Sale. Moved by George St. Hilaire, Seconded by Dan Thiessen: #236/80. Resolved that By Law No. 1144, being a By Law of the Municipality of Morris, to appoint Officers to be responsible for the collection, regarding the sale of the Municipal History Book, in the Legion Hall, on October 18, 1980, be introduced and read a first, and second time.

Carried.

Reeve Rempel stated that the 2,500 books weigh 15,000 lbs. Only a portion of the books are to be shipped, and the cheapest the rest could be stored is at \$116.00 per month, at Inter-Collegiate Press.

Gravel-Snarr Rd. Moved by George St. Hilaire, Seconded by Wm. F. Recksiedler: #237/80. Resolved that 2 Loads of Gravel be placed on Allan Snarr's Road.

Carried.

Bridge Repair -NE -20, 17-5-1E. Moved by A. K. Fast, Seconded by Dan Thiessen:

#238/80. Resolved that we repair the Bridge on the NE 20-5-1E, Morris River Bridge, and check and repair, if feasible, the bridge on the NE 17-5-1E.

Carried.
