

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held a special meeting at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, April 13, 1981 in the Council Chambers at the Town of Morris with Reeve Alvin Rempel presiding. Present were councillors: Lenore Eidse, Roy Kornelsen, George St. Hilaire, Dan Thiessen and W. Glenn Curdt. The meeting was held to deal with the remainder of the agenda from the April 9, 1981 meeting.

- Sperling Rink Councillor Glenn Curdt advised council that progress payments to B&B Steel Builders re the Sperling Rink in the amount of \$41,000.00 are due and should be paid as soon as possible. He also noted that further billings of \$53,000.00 were to come shortly.
- Ad for Building Permits After a letter was read by the acting Secretary-Treasurer, concerning the Red River Designated Flood Area, it was decided that an ad should be placed in the Scratching River Post to notify residents of the requirements. Councillor Roy Kornelsen noted that the December 11, 1980 minutes stated that the Planning Committee should aid the Secretary-Treasurer in preparing the ad.
- Dog Licenses It was decided that dog licenses should be renewed yearly, in accordance with by law 1109. An ad will be placed in the Scratching River Post to coincide with the Town of Morris veterinary clinic. Councillor Dan Thiessen was to inquire as to the specific dates.
- Billing for Fire Calls Councillor Dan Thiessen presented a report on the systems used by the surrounding municipalities for billing of fire calls. After a discussion, Reeve Alvin Rempel suggested that a further investigation should be made into the various insurance companies' policies on coverage for different types of fires, and reimbursement of charges for fire calls.
- Auditor's Report The report from the auditor was discussed briefly, and Reeve Alvin Rempel pointed out the necessary credits to be charged to the Rosenort Fire Hall, and concluded that an additional \$2831.53 would be left to be raised once the purchase of the lot for the Fire Hall was completed.
- Gravel ED Lohr's road Councillor George St. Hilaire was asked to inquire about the costs for the municipality to become member of the St. Pierre Veterinary Clinic. It was agreed to resume to the distribution system of the fall of 1980 for the patrolling of roads by the equipment crew. Moved by George St. Hilaire, Seconded by Roy Kornelsen: #108/81. Resolved that we gravel approximately two miles of road to Ed Lohr's property at 200 yards per mile, south of River Lot 402. Carried. Councillor Wm. F. Recksiedler arrived at 8:20 p.m.
- Nuisance Grounds Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by Wm. F. Recksiedler: #109/81. Resolved that we ask Mr. Toews to clean nuisance grounds at Rosenort on a trial basis at \$30.00 per hour. Carried.
- Request to PRFA re raising water dams Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by Lenore J. Eidse: #110/81. Resolved that we write a letter to the P.F.R.A. requesting a study regarding the feasibility of raising stock watering dams on the Morris River. Carried.
- Culverts Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by Glenn Curdt: #111/81. Resolved that we purchase culverts from Armco- 4- 12' metric 500mm., 4- 24' metric 500mm., 14- 12' standard 18", 4- 24' metric 600mm., 14- 12' standard 24", 4- 12' metric 600mm., 4- metric couplers 600mm., 4- metric couplers 500mm., 7- standard couplers 18", 7 standard couplers 24". Carried.
- Bridge Repairs Councillor Dan Thiessen presented a report on repairs needed on bridges. It was suggested that each councillor check the bridges in their respective wards, listing the ones having priority for repairs and report to council at a later meeting. Councillor Glenn Curdt brought forward a request for a culvert by Ralph Pfrimmer on 20-6-2W. No further discussion ensued since council had passed a resolution on this same request previously.




