

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held a special meeting at 10:00 A.M., July 23rd, 1981 to hear objections to the proposed local improvement project for sewer and water for Rosenort, Manitoba.

Reeve Alvin Remple presided. Present were Councillors: Glenn Curdt, W. F. Recksiedler, George St. Helaire, Lenore J. Eidse, Dan Thiessen. Councillor Roy Kornelson was absent.

L.I.D.#2 Moved by Lenore J. Eidse, Seconded by W. G. Curdt:  
By-law Resolved that By-law No. 1169/81, being a by-law of the Rural  
1169/81 Municipality of Morris for the purpose of creating Local Improvement  
District No. 2 be now introduced and read a first time.  
Carried.

Water & Moved by George St. Helaire, Seconded by Dan Thiessen.  
Sewer Resolved that By-law No. 1170/81, being a by-law of the Rural  
By-law Municipality of Morris, for the purpose of authorizing the construction  
1170/81 and installation of sewer and water in the U.V.D. and Community  
of Rosenort, and the issue of debenture debt, be now introduced  
and read a first time.  
Carried.

After giving first reading to By-law No.'s 1169/81 and 1170/81, the floor was then open to hear representations for or against the proposed project. There were no presentations to Council or persons present at this hearing.

By-law Resolved that it is deemed expedient and in the best interest of  
1169/81 the Municipality that By-law No. 1169/81 be now given second and  
third reading, and finally passed with the requirements of Section  
183(2) of the Municipal Act be now suspended and that the by-law  
be signed by the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer.

Water & Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by George St. Helaire.  
Sewer Whereas By-law No. 1165/81 of the Rural Municipality of Morris  
By-law has been given first reading on the 25th day of June, 1981;  
1165/81 And Whereas the Council of the R. M. of Morris wish to amend the  
Amendment above mentioned by-law;  
Therefore Be It Resolved that Council enacts as follows:  
1. that clause 3 of By-law No. 1165/81 which presently reads in  
part as follows: "... shall be dated the 1st day of November,  
A.D. 1982..." shall now be amended to read: "... shall be dated  
the 1st day of November, A.D. 1981 ..."  
Carried.

Upon the unanimous consent of Council the following topics relating to gravel hauling, calcium chloride for Sperling and Lowe Farm, Planning, the Game & River Fish Assoc. custom work account, bridges and truck tenders were discussed and desired action taken by Council regarding the matters involved.

Delegation Mr. Ed. Groening met with Council requesting to have gravel put on the road connecting him to Highway # 23. Council had previously decided not to continue with graveling this road between Sec. 32 & 33-4-2W for a distance of one mile south from Highway # 23. Due to there being another road built for his use, Councillor Dan Thiessen explained as to why council decided to discontinue graveling this road. Mr. Groening indicated that there has been considerable expense to the road in question to be just left and the new road is still soft. At this point the matter was left to Council.

Resolved that we do now make <sup>partial</sup> payment in the amount of \$40,000.00 to the R. M. of Morris Truckers Association for the 1981 graveling done by them for the Rural Municipality of Morris.
