

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held a Special Meeting at 9:00 A.M. on Wednesday, September 2nd, 1981 in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris with Reeve Alvin Rempel presiding. Present were Councillors: George St. Helaire, Glenn Curdt, Lenore Eidse, Wm. F. Recksiedler, Dan Thiessen, Roy Kornelsen. The meeting was held to deal with the remainder of the agenda from the August 13th, 1981 meeting. This meeting was to be held on August 27th, 1981, however, good weather caused the postponement of the meeting.

There was considerable discussion of Council regarding the Municipalities Bridge Truck as to whether to buy a new truck or to repair the existing truck and to look for an older 3 ton truck to do the heavy hauling.

Moved by Roy Kornelsen, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:  
#253/81. Whereas the Council of the R. M. of Morris had apparently given first reading to By-law No. 1155 at a meeting held March 18, 1981. And Whereas there are no recorded minutes of the meeting on March 18th, 1981;  
And Whereas By-law No. 1155 concerns the rezoning of certain properties in Rosenort, Manitoba and Council deems it expedient to commence with this by-law;  
Therefore Be It Resolved that By-law No. 1155 be hereby now given first reading in Council as a whole, rules suspended, and that this resolution shall take precedent over any other resolution pertaining to the giving of first reading to this by-law.

- Wiens Subdivision SE 6-5-1W Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:  
#256/81. Whereas Roland & Susan Wiens have made application to subdivide part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 6-5-1W and has been given file number 7-79-1279;  
Therefore Be It Resolved that Council of the R. M. of Morris does now approve the proposed subdivision of Roland and Susan Wiens on the condition that the proposed parcel be rezoned from "A-40 Agricultural District" to that of "R-A Residential District".

- Eidse Subdivision Lots 15,16 Plan 5115 Moved by Roy Kornelsen, Seconded by George St. Helaire:  
#257/81. Whereas Minnie Eidse has made application to subdivide part of Lots 15, 16, Plan 5115 and has been given file number 36-80-1844;  
Therefore Be It Resolved that Council of the R. M. of Morris does now approve the proposed subdivision of Minnie Eidse on the condition that a variation order reducing the site area requirement from 20,000 sq. ft. to 19,000 sq. ft. be acquired for the parcel retained by Minnie Eidse.

- Brandt Subdivision NE 34-5-2W Moved by Roy Kornelsen, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:  
#258/81. Whereas Elmer & Anne Brandt have made application to subdivide part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 34-5-2W and has been given file number 36-81-1944;  
Therefore Be It Resolved that the Council of the R. M. of Morris does now approve the proposed subdivision on the condition that the residual 40 acres of CT# 15535 of this subdivision be consolidated with the north 40 acres of this quarter of CT# A15450.

- There was then considerable discussion regarding the new Riverside Bridge and Mrs. Eidse indicated to Council that she feels that the road dip be filled in as it is not required for this bridge. Some members of Council felt that the dip was necessary to alleviate stress during extreme conditions. The matter was finally left with Council going to view the situation prior to our September 10, 1981 regular meeting.
- Reservoir Land Purchase Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by W. F. Recksiedler:  
#259/81. Whereas Mary J. Loewen is the owner of Lot 6, except Rd. 968, in Plan 693 which is a 4.85 acre parcel of land;  
And Whereas the R. M. of Morris wishes to construct a concrete water reservoir on this property as well as for other municipal uses;  
Therefore Be It Resolved that the R. M. of Morris agrees to purchase all of this property at \$1,500.00 per acre and the Secretary-Treasurer be authorized to draw up the necessary agreement.

- Moved by Lenore Eidse, Seconded by Dan Thiessen:  
#260/81. Whereas in accordance to Mr. J. Cousin's letter of August 21st, 1981 there are certain easements which the municipality requires in order to complete the installation of sewer and water at Lowe Farm, Manitoba;  
Therefore Be It Resolved that the Secretary-Treasurer be now authorized to have prepared such agreement documents as will be necessary to facilitate this work.
