

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular meeting at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, December 10th, 1981 in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

Reeve Alvin Rempel presided.

Present were Councillors: Dan Thiessen, W. F. Recksiedler, Roy Kornelsen, Glenn Curdt, Lenore Eidse.

- Minutes Moved by Roy Kornelsen, Seconded by W. F. Recksiedler:
#415/81. Resolved that the minutes of the November 12, 1981 meeting and the November 19th, 1981 special meeting be now adopted as recorded and the reading of same shall be waived.
Carried.
- Represent. Moved by W. G. Curdt, Seconded by Dan Thiessen:
Morris #416/81. Resolved that Mr. Don Lewis be appointed as our
Hosp. Bd. citizen representative to the Morris Hospital District #25 for a
3 year term beginning January 1, 1982.
Carried.
- Rat Control Moved by Lenore Eidse, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:
Seminar #417/81. Resolved that Dan Thiessen and Willie Penner and Roy
Kornelsen be authorized to attend the seminar on January 20, 1982
regarding the Provincial Rat Control Program.
Carried.
- Committee Lenore Eidse reported to Council on the Morris Community Centre
Report District. District was formally establishing itself and would be
commencing operation as of January 1, 1982. A proposed budget for
the year 1982 was presented to Council. The discussion on the budget
included items of tractor rental, insurance, portable bleachers and
hot water tank and which council felt that further information
should be obtained on some of these items. Also discussed were
proposed amendments to the agreement with the Town which established
the district.
- Morris Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by W. F. Recksiedler:
C.C.D. #418/81. Resolved that the Council of the R. M. of Morris does now
'82 Budget tentatively approve the budget for the Morris Community Centre
District for 1982 with the provision that items of insurance and
tractor rental be further clarified to Council.
Carried.
- Council then recessed for lunch at 12:00 noon to reconvene at
approximately 1:15 P.M.
- Delegation Mr. Doug Penner representing the Morris Community Development
Corporation explained to Council that the long term goals of the
Corporation is to attract industry to Morris and area. As recreation
is an important part in attracting industry, they proposed to
establish a recreation study committee. This committee would review
all existing facilities and would look at aspects of new facilities,
repairing old facilities, and the funding for any projects of this
nature. Mr. Penner asked that if the R. M. of Morris is interested
in this approach, a representative should be appointed from Council
to this committee.
- Amend Moved by Lenore Eidse, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:
Morris #419/81. Resolved that we accept the following amendments to the
C.C.D. Morris Community Centre District agreement:
Agreement Section 3(a) to read - "28% by the R. M. of Morris".
Section 5(c) to read - "two members from the Council of the
Town, and one who shall sit as Chairman".
Section 8 to read - "That one member of the Board who is a
member of the Town Council shall be the Chairman
and shall have the tie breaking vote".
Section 13 to read - "If either party wishes to terminate the
agreement, such termination shall take effect
on July 1st of any given year with at least three
months advance notice."

- W Lowe Farm Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by Roy Kornelsen:
Reservoir #420/81. Resolved that we authorize the installation of a 3 phase
Hydro hydro service to the new concrete reservoir at a charge of \$2,706.00
to Manitoba Hydro which shall now be authorized for payment.

 Aid Prog. of Grant-in-Aid street work;

 work for Lowe Farm and Sperling as was requested in 1981 and also
 for Rosenort.


Senior Cit. Moved by Roy Kornelsen, Seconded by Dan Thiessen:
