

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held a Special Meeting at 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, December 29th, 1981 in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

Reeve Alvin Rempel presided.

Present were Councillors: Lenore Eidse, Roy Kornelsen, Dan Thiessen, Glenn Curdt.

The purpose of this meeting was to meet with the public works employees to discuss the recent action taken by Council regarding their employment, and also to make payment to Q.M. Brothers and to finalize the agreement with E. L. Rance.

The Council then started the meeting by meeting with the public works employees to discuss the recent lay-offs and employees placed on standby.

There was much discussion on the matter and topics of discussion included items of why the action was taken, aspects of Unemployment Insurance, holiday privileges, 1 hour travel time, salaries of other municipalities, notification of when to come in to work and who is to notify, employee benefits while on standby and while laid off. Many of the topics were answered to the satisfaction of the employees and it was generally decided that the standby employees are to be notified by a Councillor to come in to work. For the U.V.D. of Rosenort, the employee may be phoned by the committee member however, the employee is to use his own discretion regarding the amount time spent in the U.V.D. For a general snow storm the employee is to automatically come in to work.

It was agreed with the employees that they would start the lay-off effective after January 1st, 1982 and would come back to work on March 1st, 1982.

Those on standby would also start on January 1st, 1982 and will be back to regular time on March 1st, 1982.
