
Reeve Alvin Rempel presided.  
Present were: Councillors Lenore Eidse, Roy Kornelsen, Glenn Curdt W. F. Recksiedler, Dan Thiessen.


The purpose of this special meeting was to finish our regular meeting of April 8th, 1982 and to review and decide upon the gravel hauling tenders received.

- Gravel Hauling Tender Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by Roy Kornelsen.  
#125/82. Resolved that we accept the gravel hauling tender bid from the Rural Municipality of Morris Truckers Association for the amount of 17½ cents per cubic yard mile hauled.  
Carried.
- Land purchase Rosenort S. & W. Moved by Roy Kornelsen, Seconded by Lenore Eidse/  
#126/82. Resolved that we authorize payment of the following accounts:  
Braun & Schmidt Trust Fund \$500.00  
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and which funds are to be on deposit for the purchase of property for a dugout for the sewer and water system for Rosenort as stated under By-laws No. 1199/82 and 1200/82.  
Carried.
- Grant-in-Aid Sperling Lowe Farm Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by W. F. Recksiedler.  
#127/82. Resolved that we request the Department of Highways for Grant-in-Aid for the portions of road in Sperling and Lowe Farm, as follows:  
Sperling: Elevator Street - P.R.#336 - United Grain Growers  
Station Street - P.R.# 336 - P.R.# 603  
Wadell Street - P.R.# 603 - New Street  
New Street - Robert Street - P.R.# 603  
  
Lowe Farm: Reimer Street - P.T.H.# 23 - First Ave.  
Second Street - P.T.H.# 23 - First Ave.  
Third Street - P.T.H.# 23 - First Ave.  
Fifth Street - P.T.H.# 23 - First Ave.  
The above is for gravel and calcium for the total of \$6,000.00 with the 50% being \$3,000.00 from the Government.  
Carried.
- Mower parts Moved by W. F. Recksiedler, Seconded by Lenore Eidse.  
#128/82. Resolved that we authorize the following parts for our tractors and mowers:  
light, lift rod, snap rings, port cap for the tractor and knives and runners for the mowers.  
Carried.
- Gravel Moved by W. F. Recksiedler, Seconded by Lenore Eidse.  
#129/82. Resolved that we authorize the placement of gravel at the following locations:  
Riverside Bridge 28 yards  
NE corner of 12-4-2W 10 yards  
Carried.
- Delegation Mr. Levi Brandt of the Rural Municipality of Morris Truckers Association met with Council to discuss their tender bid. Council indicated that they establish one contact person for the R.M.M.T.A. to handle complaints and problems. They indicated that this could be done.  
The matter of the trucks being weighed was brought up and this caused some discussion. It was indicated and consented to by Council that a standard weight measure for a cubic yard should be 2,800 pounds per tonne. They indicated that using weight measure their tender bid of 17½ cents per cubic yard was the equivalent of 13.8 cents per metric tonne per mile or 12.5 cents per ton per mile.

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- Fire Agree with Town Council discussed the proposed Fire Department agreement with the Town of Morris. Council, after much discussion on the matter, recommends the original agreement of 1 mill operating and 1.5 mills for capital, however, Council would consider a proposal of 2 mills for operating and no capital contributions.
- Morris C.C.D. Councillor Lenore Eidge reported to Council on the Morris Recreation District. She indicated that the matter of the tractor rental from the Town for the arena had still not been adequately resolved. She stated that the Board would be requesting tenders for a tractor for rental. ~~purchase~~.
- Grader Repairs Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by W. F. Recksiedler. #130/82. Resolved that we authorize necessary repairs to the crankshaft and motor of our John Deere motor grader and also a universal joint for our Champion grader.  
Carried.
- Bridge lumber Councillor Dan Thiessen initiated discussion regarding the purchase of bridge timbers which are needed. As planking was stated as the current need, Mr. Thiessen is to phone suppliers to obtain prices for this lumber. Mr. Willie Penner was to be requested to inform Council on bridges which need repairs and Council would review same and determine their priority rating.
- Adjourn The meeting was adjourned at 12:15 P.M.
