THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular meeting at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, July 8, 1982 in the Council Chambers of the R.M. of Morris.

Alvin Rempel presided, Present were Councillors Dan Thiessen, Lenore Eidse, Roy Kornelsen, Glenn Curdt, W.F. Recksiedler, and George St. Hilaire

- Minutes Moved by Lenore Eidse, Seconded by George St. Hilaire #208/82. Resolved that the minutes of the June 10th, 1982 regular meeting and June 24th, 1982 special meeting be now adopted as recorded and the reading of same shall be waived.
Carried.
- Jacob Dueck subdivision Moved by Lenore Eidse, Seconded by Roy Kornelsen #209/82. Whereas Jacob P. Dueck and Diana M. Dueck had made application to subdivide part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18-5-1 East which was given planning file no. 36-81-2028; And Whereas it was recommended to Council that the land being transferred be consolidated with Certificate of Title No. B46149; And Whereas the property under C.T. #B46149 does not belong to the subdivision applicant and therefore cannot be consolidated; And Whereas Council of the R.M. of Morris wrongly followed this recommendation requesting that this consolidation take place as a condition of the subdivision approval; Therefore Be It Resolved that the Rural Municipality of Morris does now withdraw this condition of subdivision approval.

- Community Recreation levy Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by Roy Kornelsen #210/82, Resolved that we pay our Community Recreation Districts $\frac{1}{3}$ of their levies on July 1 st and the remainder by October 30 of each year.

- Grading roads Considerable discussion regarding the grading of roads in the municipality and operators are to be asked to grade Rosenort streets at least bi-weekly.
- Garrison donation Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by George St. Hilaire #211/82, Resolved that the R.M. of Morris does now donate \$100.00 to the Action Committee Against Garrison for the purpose of helping defray costs of a delegation to Washington , D.C.

- Recessed for lunch at 12:00 noon and reconvened at 1:00 P.M.
- The Reeve was unable to attend the meeting immediately after lunch and Deputy Reeve Dan Thiessen chaired the meeting at this time.

- Variation Board Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by Roy Kornelsen Resolved that the Council of the R.M. of Morris does now resolve into the Variation Board of the R.M. of Morris to consider application no. 3/82 from Edwin P. Dueck and no. 2/82 from John D. Loewen.


Tires
