

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular meeting at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, August 12th, 1982 in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

Reeve Alvin Rempel presided.

- Minutes Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by W. F. Recksiedler:  
#260/82. Resolved that the minutes of the July 8th, 1982 regular meeting and the July 16th and July 22nd, 1982 special meetings be now adopted as read.  
Carried.
- Mun. Bd. Moved by Roy Kornelsen, Seconded by Lenore Eidse:  
Hearing #261/82. Resolved that Councillor Glenn Curdt be authorized to attend  
in Carman the Municipal Board hearing in Carman, Manitoba on September 22, 1982 which is being held for the formation of a Planning District.

U.M.M. #262/82. Resolved that the R. M. of Morris make a donation of \$287.50 to the Union of Manitoba Municipalities for the purpose of being placed against their mortgage principal payment.

Lowe Farm to do all things necessary to bring the streets and lanes in Plan 522  
Streets in Lowe Farm under the new system of recording in the Morden Land Titles Office.

Therefore Be It Resolved that the R. M. of Morris has no objections to this land being returned to the owners of land on Section 22-4-1 West affected by this drain.

from sewer and water system into Rosenort, Manitoba;  
A. Rempel And Whereas the Proposed site for the sewage lagoon is on the  
NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 9-6-1East;  
And Whereas this property is owned by Mr. Alvin Rempel who is a member  
of the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris;  
And Whereas Mr. Alvin Rempel has agreed to sell part of the above  
mentioned property for the purpose of constructing a sewage lagoon;  
Therefore Be It Resolved that the Rural Municipality of Morris does  
now approve the entering into a contract to purchase from Mr. Alvin  
Rempel the North 780 feet of the South 1,070 feet of the West 392 feet  
of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 9, in Township 6 and Range 1 East of the  
Principal Meridian at a cost of \$527.84 per acre.

 in Township Six (6), and Range One (1) East of the Principal  
 Meridian in Manitoba, filed in the Winnipeg Land Titles office  
 as No. 8835, which lies to the East of the centre line of the  
 Morris River, excepting thereout the Southerly Two Hundred  
 and Forty-four (244) feet in depth thereof and also that we  
 purchase the North 30 feet of Lot 6, in Plan 8835.


Summer Moved by George St. Hilaire, Seconded by Roy Kornelsen:
