

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular meeting at 9:00 A.M. on Thursday, June 9th, 1983 in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

Reeve Alvin Rempel presided.

Present were Councillors: Lenore Eidse, George St. Hilaire, W. F. Recksiedler, Dan Thiessen, Glenn Curdt, Roy Kornelsen.

- Minutes Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by Roy Kornelsen:
#314/83. Resolved that the minutes of the May 12th, 1983 regular meeting and the May 19th, 1983 special meeting be now adopted as presented.
Carried.
- Low Farm Dugout Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:
#315/83. Whereas the R. M. of Morris has recently installed a new sewer and water system into Lowe Farm;
And Whereas the water dugout reservoir was designed by P.F.R.A. for this system;
And Whereas there are considerable problems with wave action and erosion of the banks and the water being silt laden;
Therefore Be It Resolved that the Rural Municipality of Morris hereby requests Mr. Gus Peterson of P.F.R.A. and Mr. E. Griffin of Agri-Water to provide all necessary finances and design measures to guarantee the Lowe Farm dugout water source to be free of erosion, excessive wave action and silty laden waters;
And Further Be It Resolved that these corrective measures are to be done and completed within the very near future in 1983.

- Bilingual Provincial Legislation Moved by Lenore Eidse, Seconded by Roy Kornelsen:
#318/83. Be It Resolved that the Rural Municipality of Morris is not opposed to bilingualism but is opposed to Manitoba being declared a bilingual province. The speaking of a Mother Tongue by residents in the R. M. of Morris of the Province of Manitoba has never been opposed in the past 100 years. We fear that the implications of such a decision would adversely effect all residents of Manitoba. The cost factor of such a program of translation and duplication of services is prohibitive in relation to the number of people it would serve. It is our desire that language rights remain as they are and that the Provincial Government should hold a provincial referendum and allow all of the people of the province to declare and voice their opinion on the matter of becoming a bilingual province.

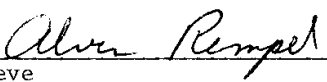
