

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held a Special Meeting at 9:00 A.M. on Thursday, July 21st, 1983 in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

Reeve Alvin Rempel presided.

Present were Councillors: Glenn Curdt, George St. Hilaire, Lenore Eidse, Dan Thiessen, Roy Kornelsen, W. F. Recksiedler.

The purpose of this meeting is to continue with the agenda of the regular meeting of July 14th, 1983.

- Low Farm Dugout P.F.R.A. Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by Glenn Curdt: #352/83. Resolved that we apply to P.F.R.A. to request financial assistance to do those things necessary to control the erosion and turbidity of the Lowe Farm dugout. Carried.
- Insurance Coverage Moved by George St. Hilaire, Seconded by W. F. Recksiedler: #353/83. Resolved that we approve our general insurance coverage as stated in a listing dated June 10, 1983. Carried.
- Assessment Reduction Roll 37200 Moved by W. F. Recksiedler, Seconded by Dan Thiessen: #354/83. Whereas the Municipal Assessment Branch have recommended that Roll No. 37200, owned by Eleanor Hiebert be reduced in assessment by \$300.00; Therefore Be It Resolved that we now approve the reduction of this house assessment to \$3,800.00 as recommended by the Municipal Assessment Branch in a letter dated June 10th, 1983. Carried.
- Delegation Mr. Mervin Dueck of Rosenort met with Council to discuss his application to the Manitoba Motor Transport Board for the purpose of obtaining a charter bus service for the Rosenort, Lowe Farm and Morris area. He is requesting Council's support for his application and any support from the Council will have to be in the manner of a personal representation at the Board hearing. His hearing with the Manitoba Motor Transport Board is scheduled for August 25th, 1983.
- M. Dueck MMTB application Moved by Lenore Eidse, Seconded by Dan Thiessen: #355/83. Whereas Mr. Mervin Dueck has applied to the Manitoba Motor Transport Board for a licence to have a charter bus service to service the area of Morris, Rosenort and Lowe Farm; And Whereas Council feels that this service would benefit the area and is needed by the communities: Therefore Be It Resolved that the Rural Municipality of Morris fully supports Mr. Mervin Dueck's application for a charter bus service. Carried.
- MMTB Hearing Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by George St. Hilaire: #356/83. Resolved that a member of Council be authorized to attend the Manitoba Motor Transport Board hearing on August 25th, 1983 to support Mr. Mervin Dueck's application for a charter bus service. Carried.
- By-law 1266/83 Moved by Lenore Eidse, Seconded by George St. Hilaire: #357/83. Whereas By-law No. 1266/83 being a by-law setting the Rosenort sewer and water rates and having been read a first time on May 12th, 1983 and having been approved by the Public Utilities Board under Board Order No. 154/83; And Whereas the municipality may now proceed with completing this by-law; Therefore Be It Resolved that the Rural Municipality of Morris does now give second and third readings to By-law No. 1266/83 with the requirements of Section 183(3) of the Municipal Act being suspended. Carried.
- Low Farm Fire Hose Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by W. F. Recksiedler: #358/83. Resolved that we now authorize the purchase of 4 - 50 foot lengths of 1½" fire hose and couplings for the Lowe Farm Fire Department. Carried.

Rosenort Lagoon Spillway Moved by Lenore Eidse, Seconded by George St. Hilaire:  
 #359/83. Resolved that Rosenort Concrete be engaged to construct a spillway for the Rosenort lagoon at a cost of \$972.00 for the concrete work.

Carried.

 #360/83. Resolved that we approve the following accounts and authorize payment of same:

 #361/83. Whereas Abram G. Kroeker and Irene Kroeker have made application to subdivide part of the SW¼ of Section 10-5-1W; Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris does now approve the subdivision on the condition that the 25 acre parcel being created have a variation order completed to vary the site area for this property.

Calcuim Lowe Farm Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:  
 362/83. Resolved that we purchase a load of calcium for the streets in Lowe Farm.

Culverts Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by W. F. Recksiedler:  
 #363/83. Resolved that we order the following culverts:  
 1 - 1880 mm x 1260mm arch - 40 feet long  
 3 - 900 mm culvert - 114 feet long (each 38 feet)  
 1 - 1400mm culvert - 42 feet long.




Bridge Repair Moved by George St. Hilaire, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:
