- Scale Operator Moved by George St. Hilaire, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:  
#365/83. Resolved that Mr. Jake Schellenberg, our gravel scale operator, be paid only for July 18, 19 and 20, 1983 and not be paid for July 21, 1983 as this is the day he quit his employment with the municipality without proper notice.

- Sec.-Treas. Holidays Moved by George St. Hilaire, Seconded by Lenore Eidse:  
#366/83. Resolved that Grant Macaulay, our Secretary-Treasurer be granted holidays from August 8, 1983 to September 2, 1983.

- Signing Author. Moved by W. F. Recksiedler, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:  
#367/83. Resolved that the Assistant Secretary-Treasurer, Mr. Roland Hamilton, be given signing authority of the R. M. of Morris for the period while the Secretary-Treasurer is on holidays.

#368/83. Resolved that the following equipment repairs be authorized:  
- repairs for starter to bridge truck  
- 740 patrol repair the hydraulic clutch system.

- Mower Blades Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by George St. Hilaire:  
#369/83. Resolved that we purchase an extra set of spare cutting blades for our new rotary mower.  
Carried.
- Bridge 10-6-1W Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by George St. Hilaire:  
#370/83. Resolved that the bridge east of Section 10-6-1W. is to be replaced with a culvert and that the culvert be ordered when the size is determined and should the bridge require emergency repairs to maintain passage, that this also be authorized.  
Carried.
- Move Piling Moved by Lenore Eidse, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:  
#371/83. Resolved that Dale Hoffman be hired to move the piling for the bridge to be built south of Riverside from the shop to the bridge site.

- Gravel Mun. Yard Moved by George St. Hilaire, Seconded by Lenore Eidse:  
#372/83. Resolved that we place 200 yards of gravel at the municipal yard in Morris.  
Carried.
- Red River Dev. Corp. Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by W. F. Recksiedler:  
#373/83. Resolved that the R. M. of Morris is in favor, in principle, with the formation of a Regional Development Corporation for the Red River Area provided that aspects of finance, etc. that concern Council are favorable to this Council.
