Moved by Lenore Eidse, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:
#414/83. Whereas the R. M. of Morris wishes to extend the water lines of the Rosenort/Riverside water system;
And Whereas Agri-Water is to be requested to do the design for this project;
And Whereas we also request technical and financial assistance from P.F.R.A. and also from Agri-Water for this project;
And Whereas the proposed tentative location of these lines are to be as follows:
North of Section 31-5-1E crossing the river
West of Section 31-5-1E
West of Section 30-5-1E
North of Section 29-5-1E crossing the river and also going east
West of Section 29-5-1E
West of Section 20-5-1E
South of Section 29-5-1E
South of Section 20-5-1E
North of Section 28-5-1E
Therefore Be It Resolved that the R. M. of Morris commence proceedings of cost estimates and installation of these line extensions as stated above.
