

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held a Special Meeting at 9:00 A.M. on Thursday, June 7th, 1984 in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

Reeve Dan Thiessen presided.

Present were Councillors: W. F. Recksiedler, Don Hamblin, Glenn Curdt, Dave Waldner, George St. Hilaire, Larry Gluck.

The purpose of this special meeting was to discuss and possibly resolve matters pertaining to our 1984 gravel program, the proposed Provincial legislation concerning Pesticide Use-Permits and the presentation of awards, etc. for former Councillors and employees.

Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by Don Hamblin:

#144/84. Resolved that the 1984 gravel program maps be now adopted as presented by the respective Councillors with the new road south of Section 17-5-1W.P.M. is to receive 140 yards of crushed rock.

During the discussion relating to the gravel program, it was calculated that our total municipal program was approximately 20,300 yards including Lowe Farm and the stockpile at the Municipal shed. The municipality would also be starting to gravel on June 11, 1984, with conditions permitting, and that the mileage from M.A.C.'s pit to highway 75 is 22 miles and from the Morris Gravel's pit to the Bank of Montreal is 7 miles.

Council did discuss the proposed pesticide permit legislation and the general reaction was in a negative manner towards this proposed legislation.

Council also discussed the matter of making presentations to recent former Council members and employees and the type of presentation which would be appropriate to make.

Following the above mentioned discussions the meeting was then adjourned at 11:40 A.M.
