Added

Moved by George St. Hilarie, Seconded by Don Hamblin:  
#155/84. Whereas Section 758 of the Municipal Act provides that a municipality may add certain assessment to the tax roll;  
And Whereas the Council of the R. M. of Morris has received a listing from the Morden Municipal Assessment Branch indicating certain property assessment which may be added to the assessment roll of the R. M. of Morris;  
Therefore Be It Resolved that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris does now authorize the property assessments listed from the Morden Municipal Assessment Branch in their letter dated June 7th, 1984 be now added to the assessment roll of the R. M. of Morris for the year 1984 as may be amended by Council.

Carried.


Sperling Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by George St. Hilaire:
