

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular meeting at 9:00 A.M. on Thursday, July 12th, 1984 in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

Deputy-Reeve George St. Hilaire presided.
Present were Councillors: W. F. Recksiedler, Dave Waldner, Don Hamblin, Glenn Curdt, Larry Gluck.

- Minutes Moved by W. F. Recksiedler, Seconded by Don Hamblin:
#174/84. Resolved that the minutes of the June 14th, 1984 regular meeting and the June 28th, 1984 special meeting be now adopted as presented.
Carried.
- St. Pierre Moved by David Waldner, Seconded by Larry Gluck:
Frog Follies #175/84. Resolved that the Reeve or Deputy-Reeve and one Councillor be authorized to attend the Frog Follies in St. Pierre on August 5th, 1984.
Carried.
- Radioactive Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by W. F. Recksiedler:
Repository #176/84. Whereas the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris is opposed to the installation of an Underground Repository for radioactive materials;
Therefore Be It Resolved that the R. M. of Morris strongly supports that no high or low level radioactive materials be placed for disposal or storage underground in the Province of Manitoba.

Frog #177/84. Resolved that we enter the float of the Rural Municipality Follies of Morris in the parade for the St. Pierre Frog Follies.

Resignation #178/84. Resolved that we regretfully accept the resignation of Roland Hamilton from his position as Assistant Secretary-Treasurer, effective August 10th, 1984 and that Council wish him well in his new career.

- Rosenort Moved by David Waldner, Seconded by Don Hamblin:
Dyke #179/84. Resolved that the R. M. of Morris is in agreement to accept the responsibility of grass mowing as the municipality's 25% share of the maintenance costs involving the flood dyke at Rosenort and that we also find acceptable the community's annual share of costs relating to future pump purchases in the amount of \$352.00 for the current proposed situation.

#180/84. Whereas the Rural Municipality of Morris wishes to haul gravel along Highway 205 from St. Pierre, Manitoba;
And Whereas a portion of P.R. 205 is under construction between St. Pierre and Aubigny;
Therefore Be It Resolved that the Department of Highways be requested to maintain that portion of P.R. 205 not under construction and also that arrangements be made at the construction location to allow vehicular traffic through this area with minimal delay.

#183/84. Whereas Jacob Eidse Bartel has made application to subdivide part of the SW¼ of Section 10-6-1E given planning file no. 36-84-2354;
Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris does now approve this application on the condition that he obtain a building permit for the proposed structure and that the building is to be at the level recommended by the Provincial Water Resources Branch and that they are to follow the Department of Highways requirements for a driveway into this property.

#184/84. Resolved that we request Manitoba Hydro to install a 250 watt street light at the intersection of 1st Avenue and Reimer Street in Lowe Farm, Manitoba with the location of the light being on the south side of 1st Avenue.

#185/84. Resolved that we request the Water Resources Branch to survey the drain along the south of Sections 31, 32 and 33, in Township 6 and Range 2 W.P.M.

#186/84. Resolved that we authorize that the following ditch be cleaned of drift dirt and upgraded on the North of Section 28-6-2W. on the north side of the road.

#187/84. Resolved that Ron Unrau be hired to use his Galleon motor grader to upgrade the lanes and ditches in Lowe Farm.

#188/84. Resolved that a 30 inch culvert approximately 50 feet long be installed at the south east corner of Section 32-6-2W.P.M. immediately west of the railway line.

#189/84. Resolved that the drain from the Rosenort lagoon be upgraded and improved to the extent that it will function properly.

#190/84. Resolved that we advertize for tender bids for the construction of 1000 feet of sidewalk in Lowe Farm and 300 feet of sidewalk in Sperling and 100 feet of sidewalk in Aubigny.
