The purpose of this special meeting is to complete the agenda from the September 13th, 1984 regular meeting and to also conduct interviews regarding the hiring of an Assistant Secretary-Treasurer for the municipality.

Moved by W. F. Recksiedler, Seconded by by Don Hamblin: #229/84. Whereas Siegmar G. H. Neuman and Wendeth A. Neuman have made application to subdivide part of the SW½ of Section 28-4-1East given planning file no. 36-84-2377; Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris approves this application on the condition that the 3 acre parcel receive the required rezoning to "A" Rural District and that a variation also take place for this three acre parcel.

Therefore Be It Resolved that we request permission from the Water Resources Branch for the R. M. of Morris to remove and retain the culverts for this crossing and to provide a driveway access from the north side of the NW_{4}^{1} of Section 36-5-1East.

Rosenort Dev.Corp. Subdiv. Moved by Dave Waldner, Seconded by Don Hamblin: #238/84. Whereas Rosenort Development Corporation Limited has made application to subdivide Block 6, in Plan 15124 in Rosenort, Manitoba given planning file no. 36-84-2342; Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris approves this application on the condition that the property is zoned to "R1" One-Family Dwelling District and also that a development agreement be entered into between the R. M. of Morris and the Rosenort Development Corporation Limited.

Reeve Dan Thiessen returned to chair the meeting and following discussion on municipal matters, the meeting was then recessed for dinner at 4:35 P.M. to reconvene at 7:00 P.M.

However, Council did entertain a proposal of his leasing the land or perhaps purchasing the land outright should proper arrangements were able to be made.
