The purpose of this special meeting is to hold a public meeting for the purpose of hearing representations concerning the upgrading, etc. for the dyke at Rosenort, Manitoba. This is intended to be done as a local improvement.

The required notice has been published and posted at Rosenort, Manitoba.

There were no persons present, other than Council, and there were no presentations or petitions made to Council regarding this public meeting.


The matter of the hearing was then adjourned at approximately 8:00 P.M.

The matter of the condition of the driveway into the Rosenort pumphouse was discussed and verbal approval was given to place approximately 126 yards of 3 inch crushed rock onto the driveway and standpipe area if this is sufficient crushed rock.

Another matter discussed was the possible purchase of a propane heater for our D7F crawler as it does not have a heater for cold weather. Verbal approval was given to purchase such a heater for a cost not to exceed \$750.00.

Council also discussed the matter of having a presentation dinner and the date for same.
