

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date present the Reeve and Councillors Leubb. Swann, Stevenson, Hebat, Braun & Ribordy

The minutes of former meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

A communication was received from North Star Oil Co re arrangement between Dykes in spillway asking for reduction of assessment the Secretary was instructed to write Co regarding same.

A letter received from Child Welfare Division re Dyke family the matter was left over for next meeting

A letter from Superintendent of C.P.R. re location of fence, mile south of M. Looish Councillor Swann & Stevenson were asked to investigate

A communication from P. H. Pomeroy was left in obedience Mr Code interviewed the Council regarding road west from Morris to Roland he stated he thought this was a very important road it might be advisable to have some gravelled under the relief or unemployment scheme.

After a discussion the following resolution was passed Moved by Councillor Swann seconded " Hebat

That a committee of three be appointed namely, Reeve Olney, Mr Leubb and Councillor Leubb to consult the Government re prospects of graveling Highway from Morris to Kone this work to be done in the form of Relief. (Carried)

Mr Bonin representing the Gestetner Co gave the Council a demonstration with a machine for printing purposes after a discussion the following resolution was passed Moved by Councillor Swann seconded " Stevenson

That this Council purchase the Gestetner printer at the special price of 292.<sup>50</sup> to be paid September 1st 1931. (Carried)

The setting of the Public works levy for the year 1931 was discussed and the following resolution passed. Moved by Councillor Braun seconded " Hebat

That the Public works levy for the year 1931 be set at 4 mills. (Carried)
