Mr Herbert of De Salabury Municipality spoke to the Council of the condition of Bridge over Boundary ditch stating that he had the bridge

to break a wheel off his rake while crossing same.  
The Council decided to have the bridge straightened up and repaired.  
Mr Bestwick spoke to the Council in regard to seed and feed grain collections he wished to know if the Council intended to collect in full in all cases. The Council decided to do so if at all possible.

Mr Roy of Sec 1-6-2 C spoke to the Council of the condition of ditch near his farm he stated that the ditch needed cleaning out as his farm was flooded every spring on account of this. He stated he would do the work and have the cost of same applied on his taxes if same was suitable to Council.

The Council agreed to this.

Mr Dudgeon spoke to the Council in regard to a grade of Sec 13-5-24 the Council informed him that on account of financial conditions it was impossible to comply with his request at the present time.
