The Clerk was instructed to advise the Municipality that the ditch in question would be of no value to Morris Municipality consequently Morris Municipality was not interested in the project.

A reply was received from Kalamazoo Municipality stating that owing to financial conditions they were not in favor of having the Lake Shore Road east of the river regraded at the present time.

Mr. Tomlinson official Justice representing Flourey Bank D.V. intervened the Council in connection with the changing of the boundaries of the said D.V.
